



**Winston Churchill.**

- Sir Winston Leonard Spencer-Churchill - British statesman and politician, Prime Minister of Great Britain in 1940-1945 and 1951-1955, respectively; soldier, journalist, writer, an honorary member of the British Academy (1952), the Nobel Prize for Literature (1953).





Winston Churchill was born on November 30, 1874 at the family estate of the Dukes of Marlborough Blenheim Palace . When Churchill was eight years old , he was sent to a preparatory school in St. George .

The school practiced corporal punishment , and Winston , constantly violated discipline , they are often subjected to . After regular visits to the nurse found the boy's body traces of vice, she immediately told his mother, and he was transferred to the school in Brighton Thomson sisters.

- . In 1886 he suffered a severe inflammation of the lungs. School he finished among the total of 12 students , who were able to withstand the exams in all subjects , particularly noted progress in learning istorii.28 June 1893 Churchill third attempt passed the exams at the Royal Military College in Sandherstedno of the most prestigious military academies UK.

# Debut in politics.

---

In July 1899 he received an offer to run for parliament from the Conservative Party from Oldham " Churchill during the campaign declared his disagreement with the law , but it had no effect , and both got a mandate from Oldham liberals. He published his only major work of art - the novel " Savrola ."



# Secretary of the Interior.

- February 14, 1910 at the age of 35 years, Churchill has served as Minister of the Interior, one of the most influential positions in the country. Ministerial salary was 5,000 pounds, and he left his literary activity, returning to this occupation until 1923.



Churchill died on January 24, 1965.

By order of the Queen seeing him were arranged by the Supreme State Council in the category of communication. Paul. In accordance with the wishes of the policy, he was buried in the cemetery of Bleydone near Blenheim Palace. The funeral ceremony was held on a scenario written in advance by Churchill.
