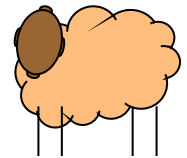

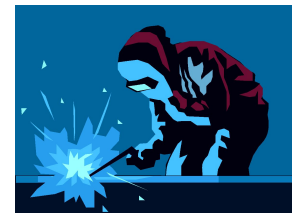

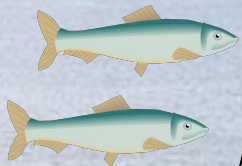

After rain comes fair weather. Rain at 7, fine at 11.**



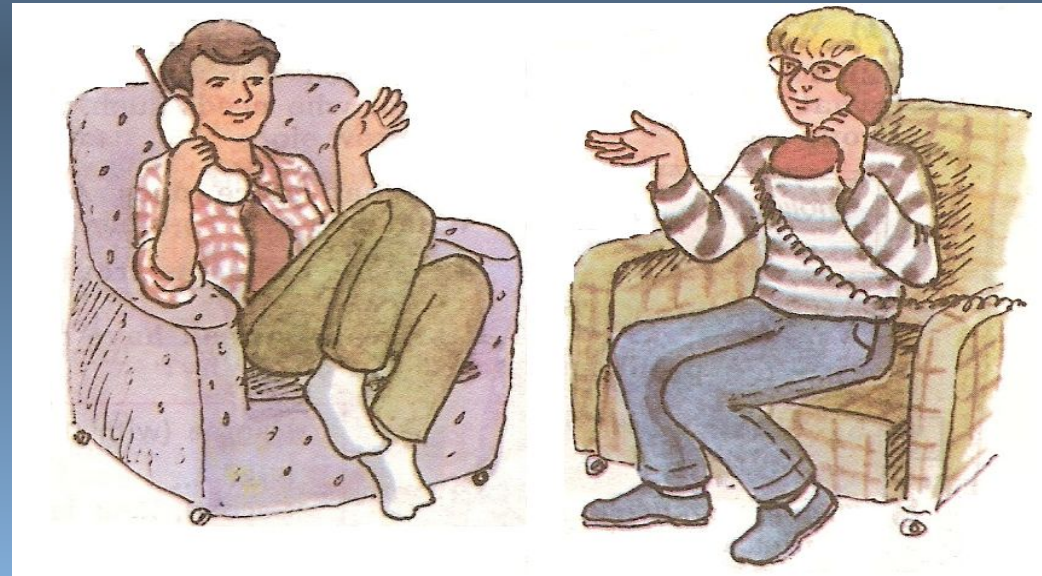




**The British weather is too changeable. It often rains. The British like to say: “If there were no clouds we shout not enjoy the sun.”**
