

Air pollution occurs when gases, dust, or smoke are introduced into the atmosphere in a way that makes it harmful to humans, animals and plants.


What causes Air Pollution?

Air pollution can be from human and natural actions. Pollution from nature is not very often.



Outdoor air pollution:

- ***Outdoor air pollution*** is caused by commercial and industrial sources. These sources are usually concentrated in big cities. The main producers are factories and transport.





Indoor air pollution

Air indoors can be polluted by cleaning products, dust, paint, insect sprays, cigarette smoke or from cooking.





NATURAL VS. CHEMICAL
CLEANING PRODUCTS

Some pollutants such as smoke and insect sprays can cause problems such as asthma.

To reduce air pollution at home you should open the doors and windows 2-3 times a day, use natural cleaning products, and do not smoke.
