A TYPICAL ENGLISH HOUSE

A SEMI-DETACHED HOUSE

It is a pair of houses which share a wall. There is usually a small garden at the back of each house. Two families live in the houses. These houses are often situated nearer the town centre. Usually they have two floors.



A DETACHED HOUSE.

This house doesn't share a wall with any other house. It is separate. There is usually a nice garden around the house. Only one family lives in such house. Usually it has two floors. It is often situated far from the town centre.



A TERRACED HOUSE

Usually many houses share side walls. They can have from one to five floors with one or two bedrooms. There are many families live in these houses. They are often situated in town centres.



A BLOCK OF FLATS

It is a high building usually with a lift. There are many families live

In the building. Usually it is situated in the town. There isn't any garden near the house.
