


Each city celebrates this day. They lit bonfires to symbolize the end of winter and the death of evil spirits. They burn the effigy of Holika, the fruits of the harvest season such as coconuts, corn, etc. are thrown into the fire too. In the morning it comes the fun: people go out and begin to wash each other with tinted colored water and throw bright colored powders at each other.
