Cole's breakthrough into literature came in 1991 with "Dangerous Lady".




The Ladykiller (1993), Good night Lady (1994), The Jump (1995), The Runaway (1997).... The last novel "Damaged" was published in 2017.








The story takes place in East London and covers the time between late 60-s and late 90-s of the last century.
