

The capital of England is London, the symbol of the country is a red rose




The capital of Scotland is Edinburgh, the symbol of the country is a thistle

An English writer of plays, one of the most famous ever, born in Stratford-upon-Avon. His plays show a great understanding of human activities of all kinds.




The Beatles




Lewis Carroll, an English writer and mathema-ticia n
