WALTER ELIAS DISNEY




Elias Walter "Walt" Disney was born on December 5th 1901 in Chicago Illinois. He was an American film producer, director, screenwriter, voice actor, animator, entertainer, international icon and philanthropist.





He liked drawing from an early age and he sold his first sketches to his neighbours when he was only seven years old. In August 1923 he left for Hollywood. He had only \$40 with him.



His brother Roy lived in California and together they started the now famous Disney Brothers studio in their uncle's garage.



LAUGH O'GRAM STUDIO

In 1920 Walt took up an interest in the field of animation, and decided to become an animator. Before reading some books, he decided to open his own animation business and recruited a fellow co-worker at the Kansas City Film Ad Company, Fred Harman, as his first employee. They titled their company "Laugh-O-Grams". Walt had started to create The Alice Comedies, which was about a real girl and her adventures in an animated world, Walt ran out of money, and his company "Laugh-O-Grams" went bankrupted.









MICKEY MOUSE

Walt created his most famous character Mickey Mouse in 1928. However, before the cartoon could be released, sound was introduced upon the motion picture industry.

















Thus, Mickey Mouse made his screen debut in Steamboat Willie, the world's first synchronized sound cartoon, which premiered at the Colony Theater in New York on November 18, 1928.

Walt won the first of his 32 Academy awards for the film **Flowers and Trees**.



Over the next five years Walt Disney made some of his most popular films such as, Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs, Pinocchio, Fantasia, Dumbo and Bambi. He made 81 films in total while he was alive.





Walt Disney Productions, Disney became one of the best-known motion picture producers in the world. The corporation he co-founded, now known as The Walt Disney Company, today has annual revenues of approximately U.S. \$35 billion.



Walt Disney's dream of a clean, and organized amusement park, came true, as Disneyland Park opened in 1955.
