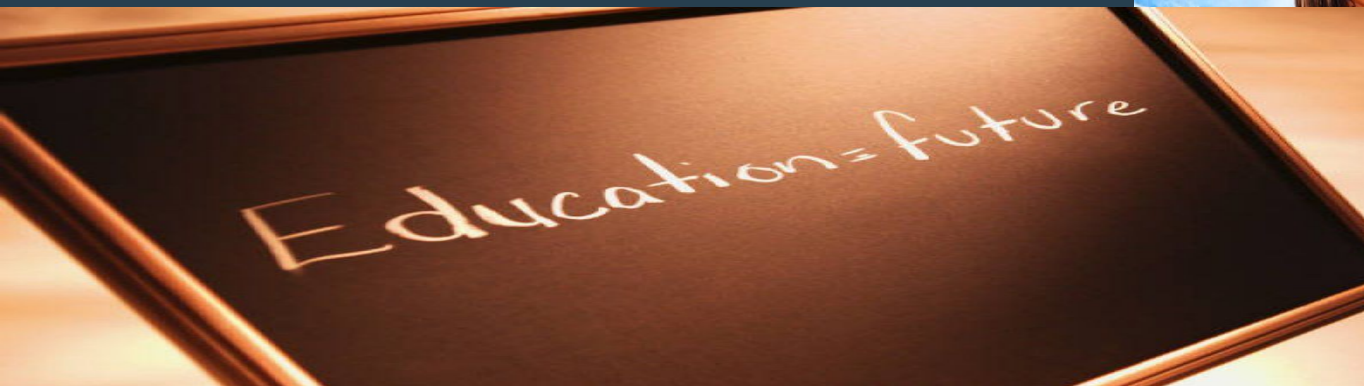


# ETYMOLOGICAL MEANING OF EDUCATION

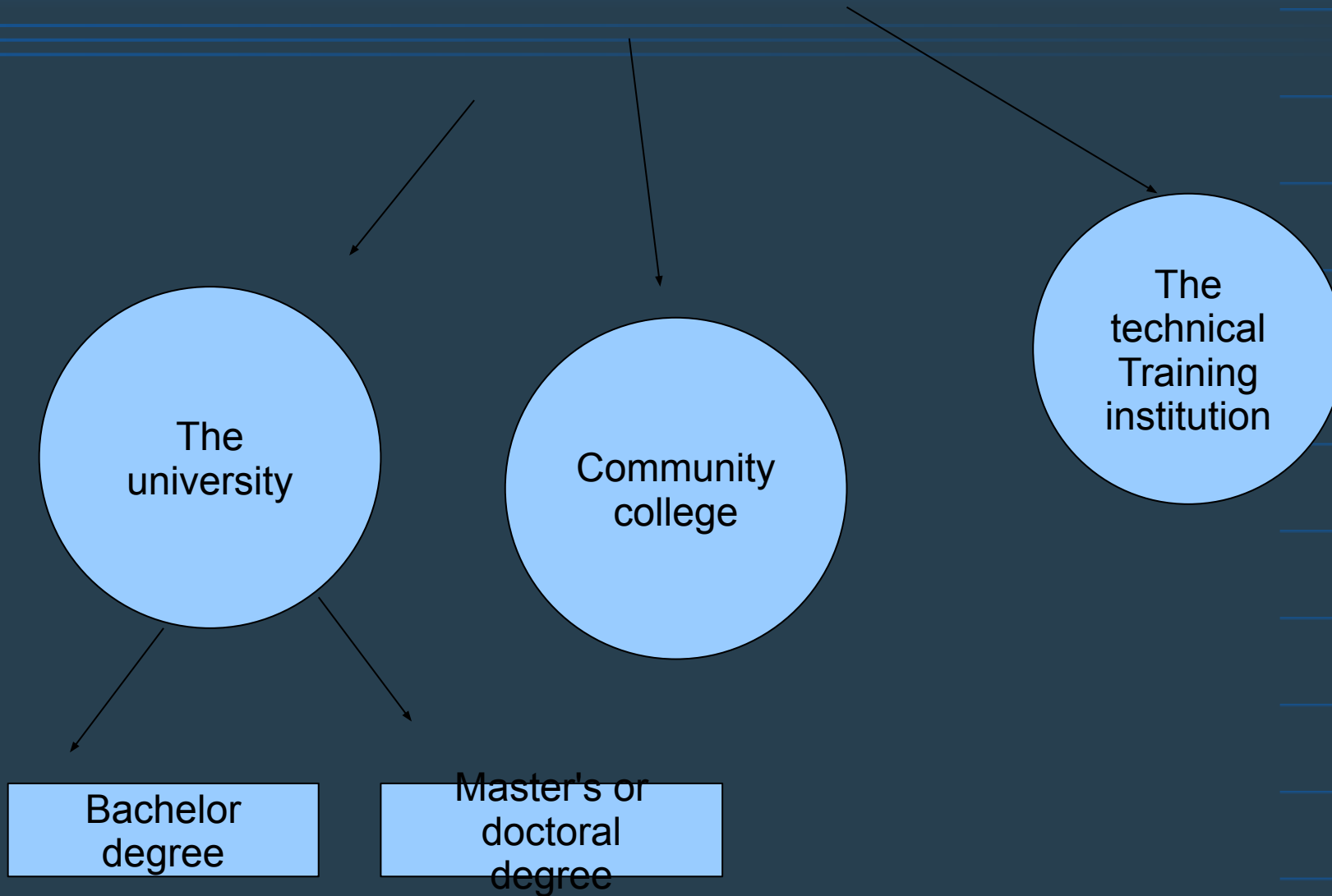
- Etymologically, the word 'Education' has been derived from different Latin words.
