
### The Thin House.

There are a lot of unique buildings in London. The funniest of them is the so-called Thin house. This three-story building resembling a gingerbread house is situated in South Kensington, in one of London's districts. One of the building's sides is a little more than one meter, and the building is delta shaped. London's Thin house is very popular among travelers.



### The Rolling Bridge.

There is an unique engineering structure in one of London's districts, Paddington. It is the Rolling Bridge. It is a type of curling movable bridge was completed in 2004. The Rolling Bridge was conceived by British designer Thomas Heatherwick. It consists of eight triangular sections. This bridge attracts many tourists.





# The smallest police station.

There is also another interesting attraction in London. It's called "The smallest police station". Formally, this place was never the police station. It's just an unusual small police box. It is situated in the corner of famous Trafalgar Square and looks like an ordinary lamp post. There is the lantern on its top. But there is also the door on the massive base, and the windows in the walls.



# The Making of Harry Potter.

There is the museum of Harry Potter in London, which was opened in 2012 in the pavilions of the studio Warner Bros., where all eight films about the young wizard have been removed. The studio is situated in the suburb Leavesden.

The museum exhibition consists of many rooms, costumes and props.
The main attraction of the museum is a 16 - meter high castle, where was the magic school Hogwarts.



# The Museum of Brands, Packaging & Advertising.



There are numerous boats along its shores. Little Venice is a corner of Italy in the heart of London.




# Hyde Park Pet Cemetery.

# Crystal Palace Park (Crystal Palace Dinosaurs).

Dinosaurs of Crystal Palace are the first sculptures of dinosaurs in the world, have appeared in 1854 at Crystal Palace Park. There are fifteen kinds of dinosaurs in this park today. The sculptures are impressive. They are dynamic and huge. There are a lot of them around the park's lake. The walk in this Park is especially interesting for children.




### Traffic Light Tree.


