And when I stand, I lie.**



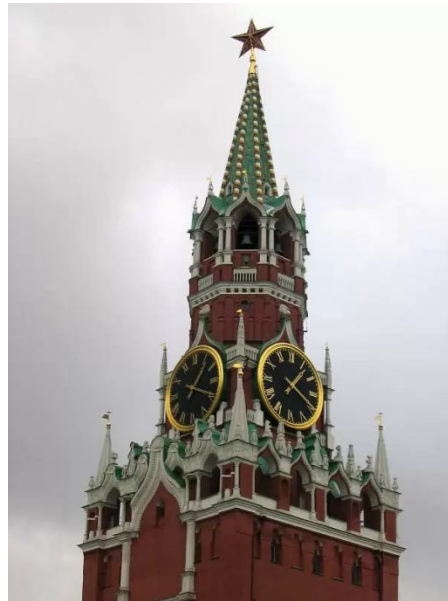

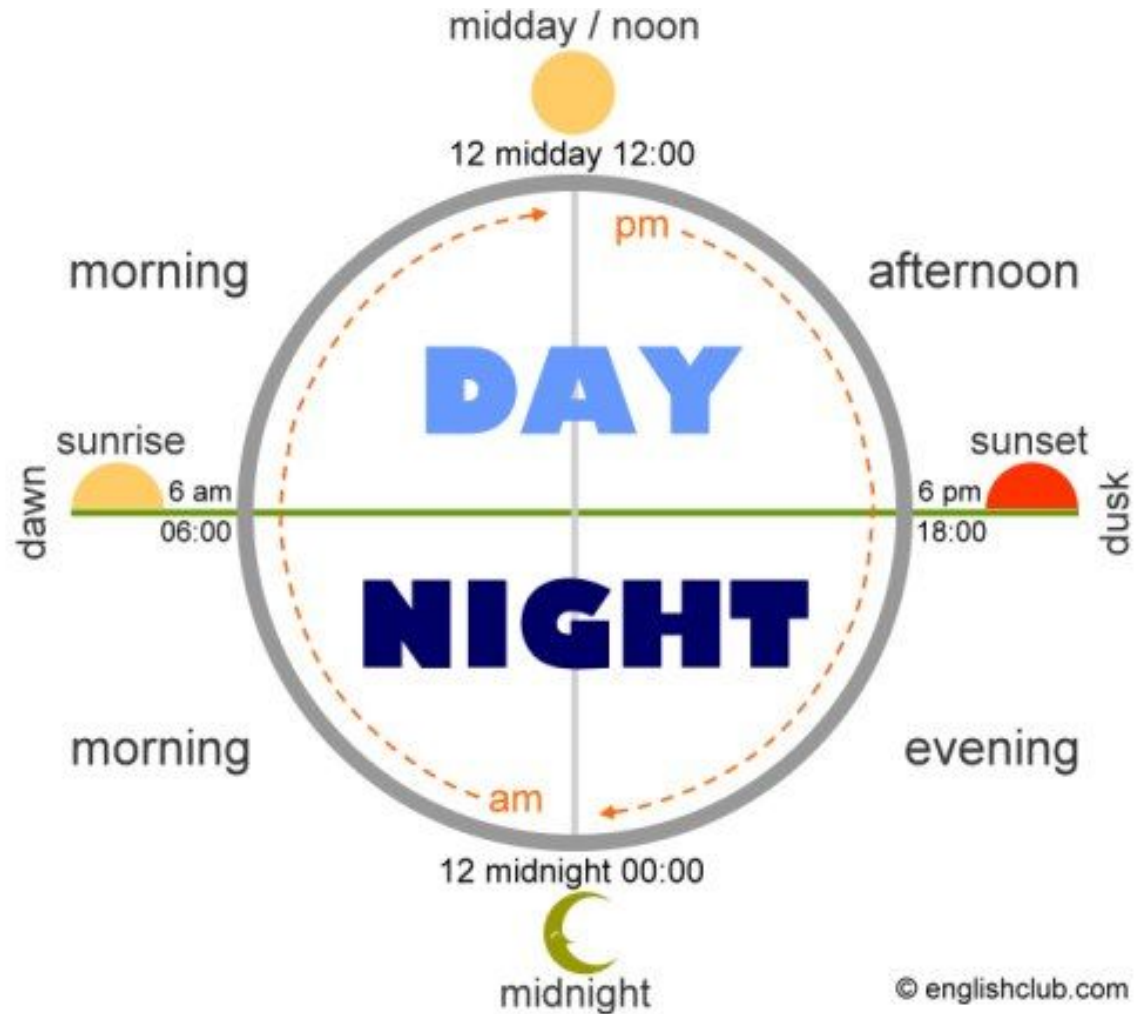


# Noon or midnight?

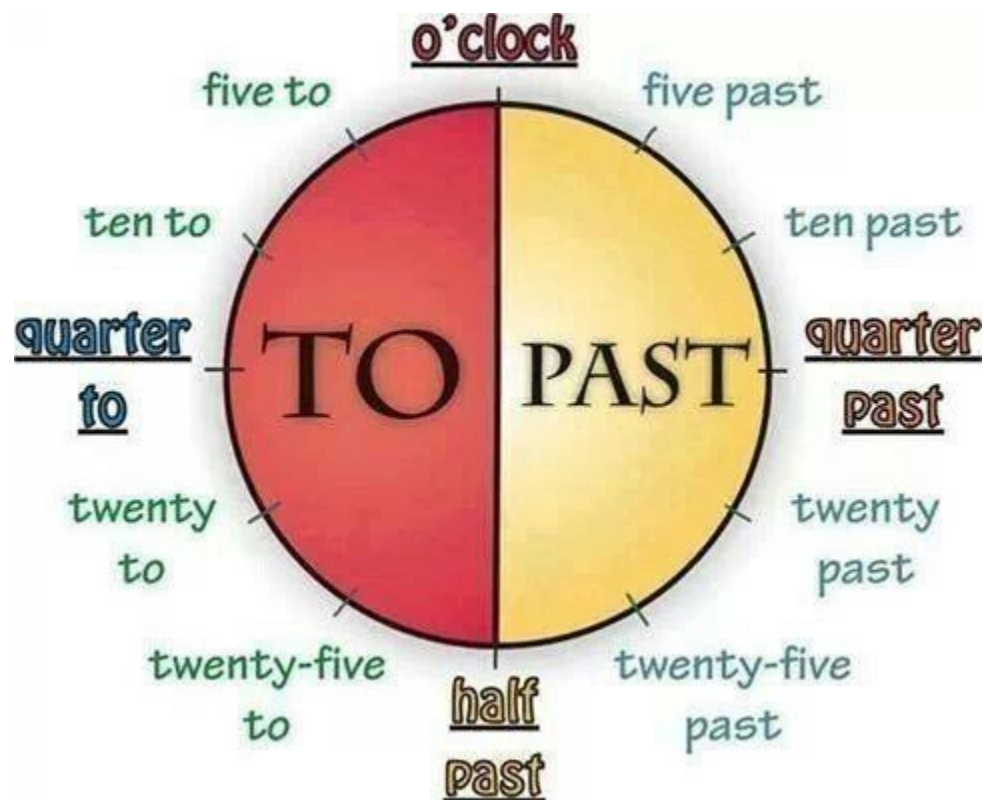




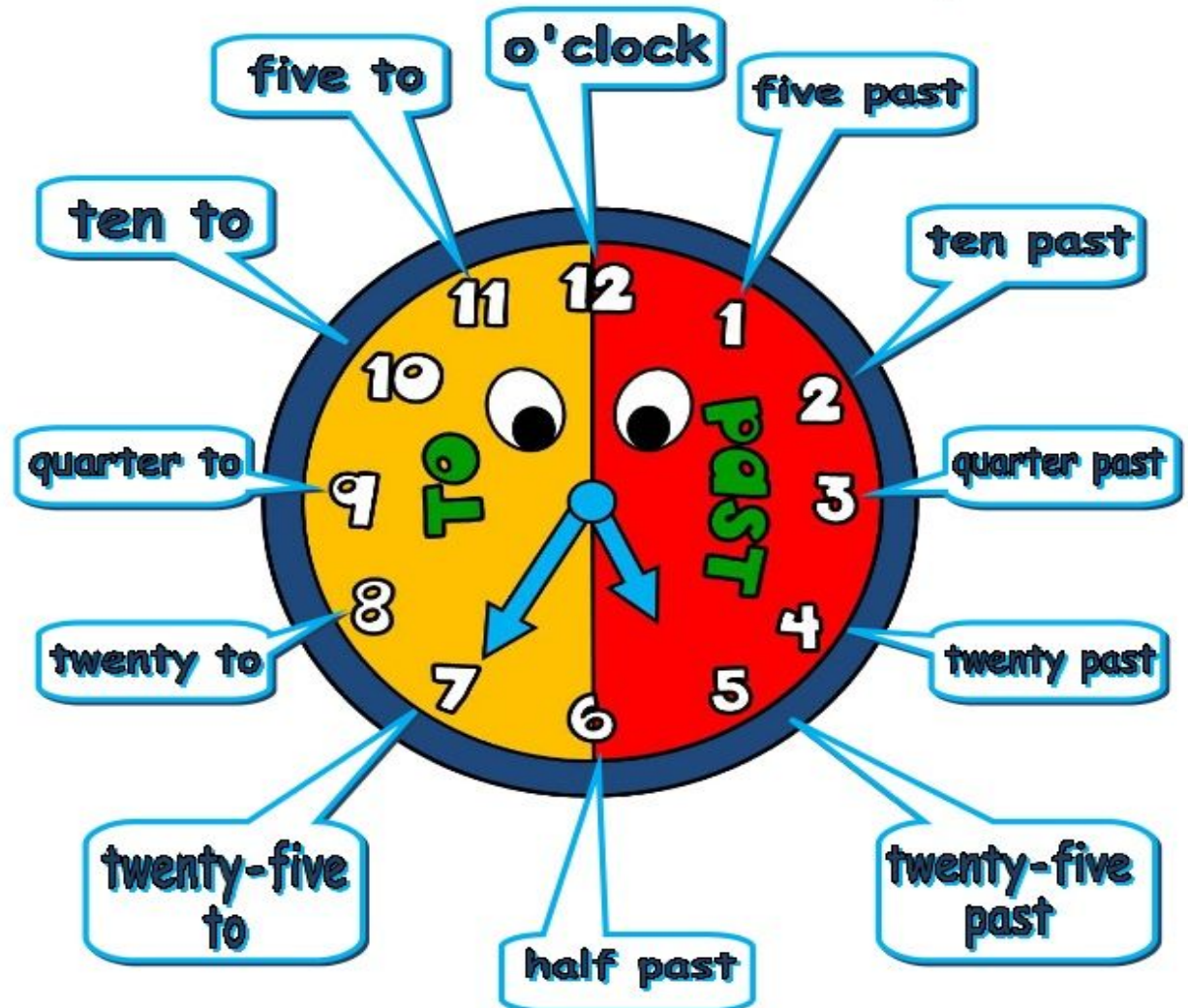

(after noon)



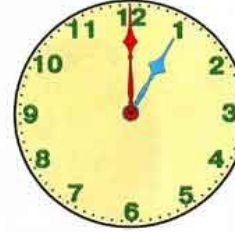

- The \_\_\_\_ is 5 minutes slow (fast).

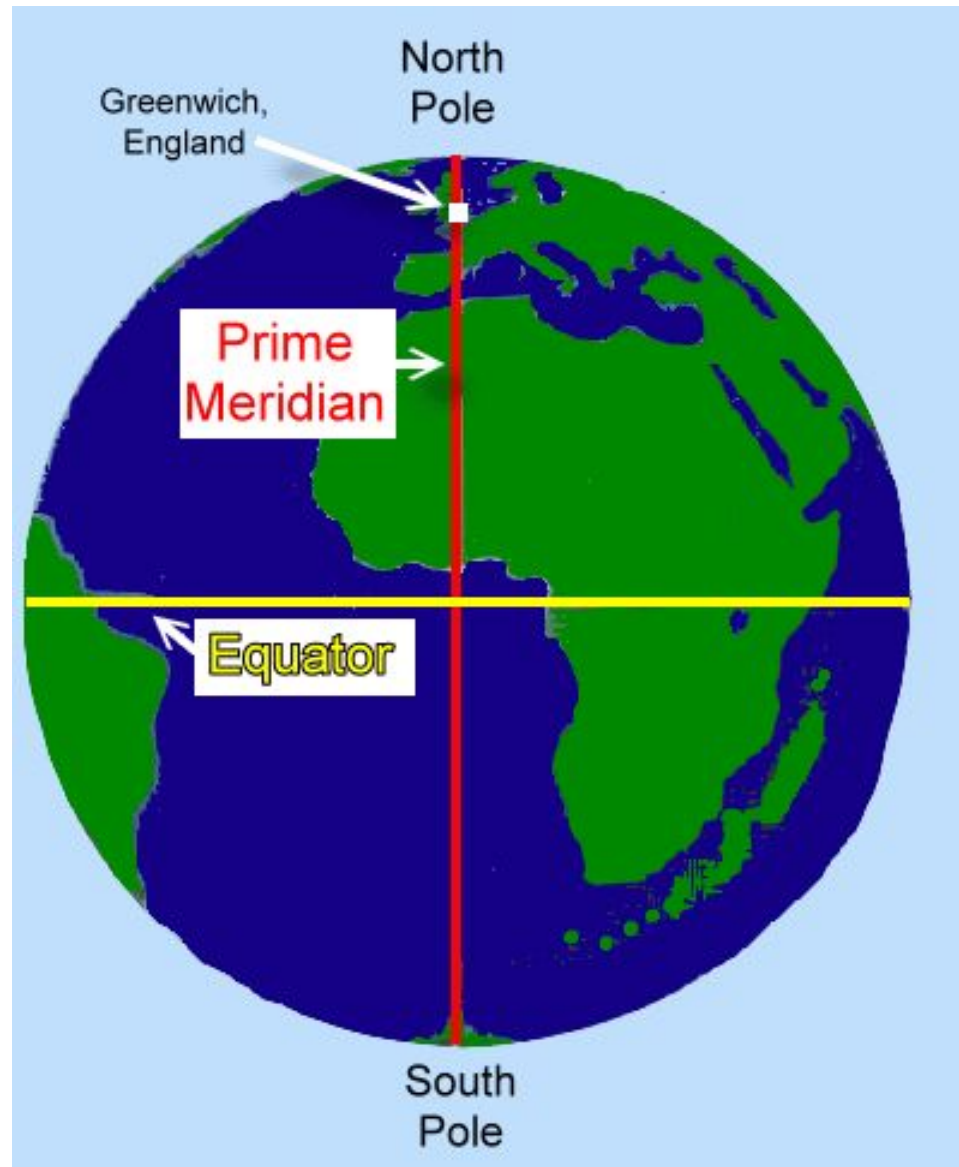

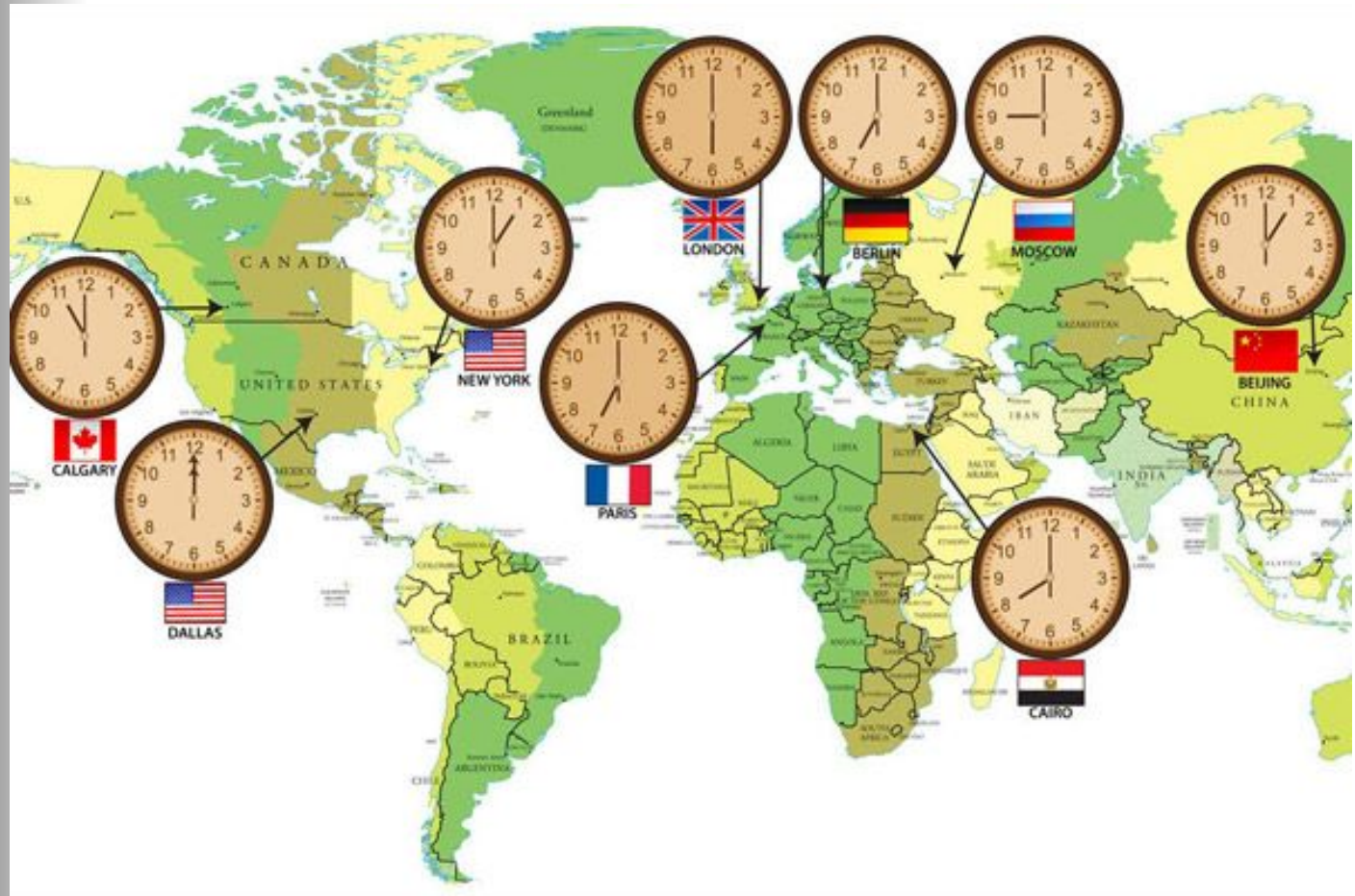
