## What's the time?

You can tell time with a clock. Moving hands on the face of a clock point to the current hour, minute, and second. Here are some examples.



It's five past nine.


9:30
It's half past nine.


It's twenty to ten.

## o'clock

We use 'o'clock' at the full hour.


It's three o'clock.


## half past

We use 'half past' to talk about any time ending in ' $: 30$ '.


It's half past eleven.
It's half past
twelve.

## past

We use 'past' to say times after the hour.

## to

We use 'to' to say times before the hour.

It's five to
eleven.
