 - being lost – потеряться
 - recognize ['rekəgnaiz] – признавать, узнавать
 - unable ['^neibl] – неспособный

- to miss – упустить, опоздать (на поезд, автобус и т.д.)
 - to fail [feil] – терпеть неудачу, провалить (экзамен)
 - to speculate ['spekjuleit] / speculating – рассуждать / рассуждения
 - doubt / to doubt [daʊt] – сомнение / сомневаться
