Olkhon island

Olkhon, the largest island of Lake Baikal, is located in the middle of the lake, near the west coast. The island is stretched along the shore of Lake Baikal, the length of Olkhon is 73 km (between the capes of Khoboy and Umysh-Tame), the width reaches 15 km. The area of Olkhon Island is about 700 sq. Km, the length of the coastline is about 210 km.



Cape Burkhan

Cape Burkhan is a magnificent white stone rock on the island of Olkhon. In order to see it, many travelers travel thousands of kilometers, coming to Baikal.

Cape Khoboy

Cape Khoboy - the northernmost cape on the island of Olkhon. The spectacular pillar-like rock, resembling an externally sharp canine, from the sea, has a pronounced similarity to the profile of a female head with a bust, as on ancient Greek galleys from the east and west.
