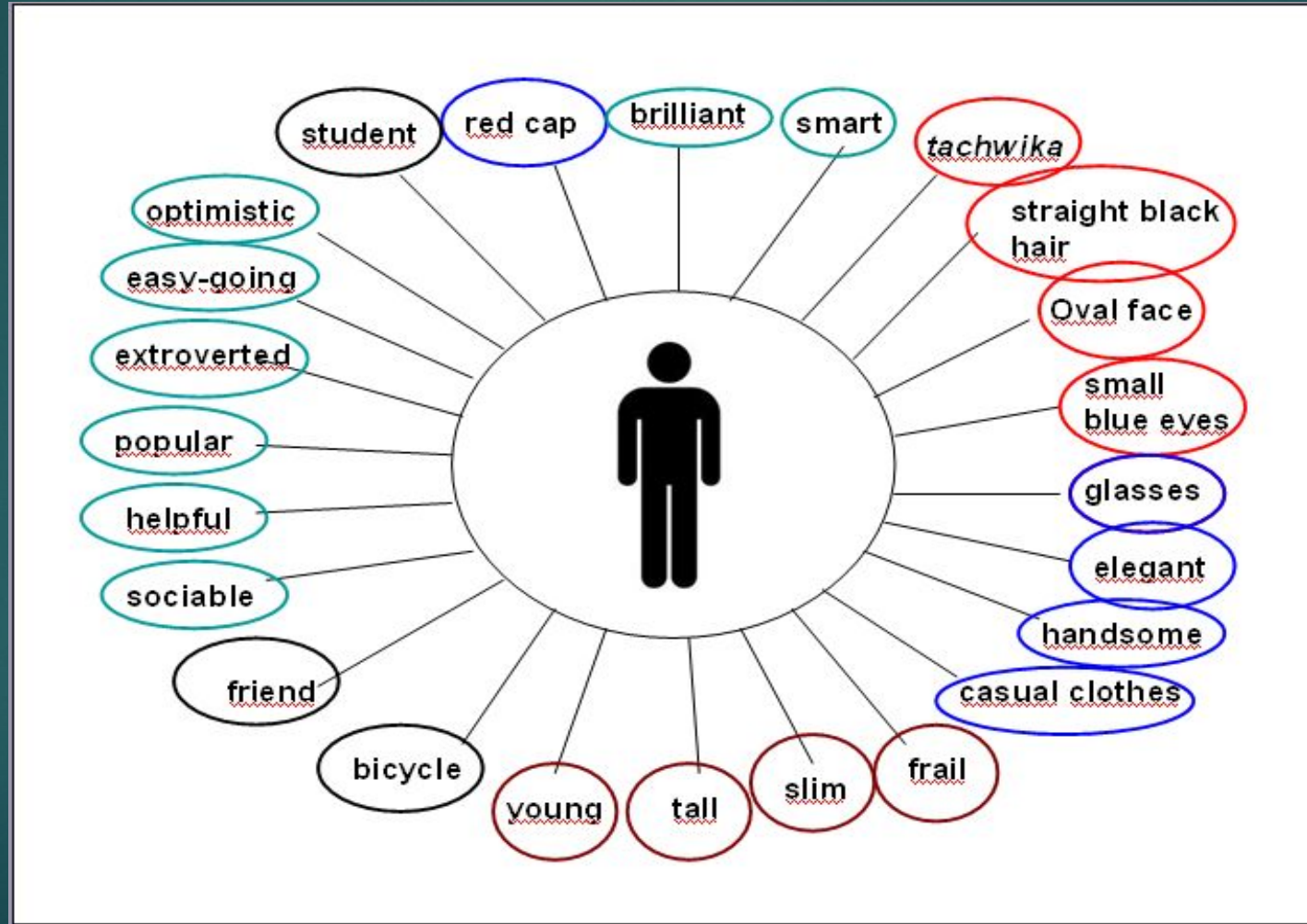



The suspects

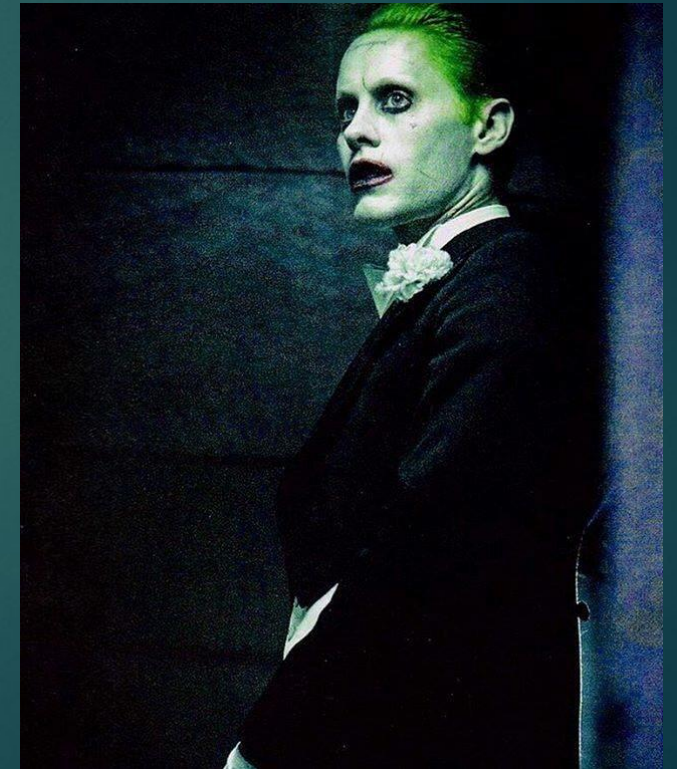


Work in pairs.
