 All students at private schools must pay. These schools are very expensive


The most famous private schools are Eton, Harrow and Winchester.


School Uniform



School uniforms were first introduced in England by **Henry VIII** and were called "bluecoats" because of blue jackets.

Then the popularity of uniforms increased and most schools had them. The uniform was different according to <u>age</u>, <u>gender</u> and even <u>season</u> (winter and summer uniforms).




