A little bit about the climate


Canada is located in the north of North America. The climate there is quite cold. In some regions winter temperature is -45°C.

The average summer temperature is +21°C .





Plants of Canada



The Canadian taiga, stretching from the northwest to the east for 4 thousand kilometers, mainly consists of black spruce and aspen in the east and white firs, pines, larches, thujas in the west.

There are also oak groves, maples, white birch, cedar, larch, mountain ash.





Animals of Canada

The fauna of Canada is very rich and diverse. Wolves, foxes, lynx and coyotes live in the wild forests.

The vilogo antelope, a species of deer live in the south. Bison and moose live in the territories of the northern and western parts of the country.






