Must, may, might, can`t -в значении предположения

- Must должно быть
- •Мау может быть
- •Might может быть (но маловероятно)
- ·Can't не может быть

Translate from Russian into English

- Они, должно быть, живут в Санкт-Петербурге.
- Они, может быть, живут в Санкт-Петербурге.
- Может быть, они и живут в Санкт-Петербурге.
- Не может быть, что они живут в Санкт-Петербурге.

Modals of speculation and deduction: could, may/might, can't and must

Look at the examples below and complete the rules with could, may/might, can't and must.

- a We use <u>could</u> and <u>might</u> to talk about things which are possible but not certain.
- b We use can't to talk about things we believe aren't true.
- c We use must to talk about things we believe are true.
- 1 His foot must hurt.
- 2 It **could** be an advertisement for a film or it **might** be an advertisement for a city.
- 3 This can't be an advertisement for a beauty product.



Note that we use *could*, *may/might*, *can't* and *must* with an infinitive without *to*.
