

has got мы используем с местоимениями he, she, it

She has got a big mouth.	She's got a big mouth.

They have got brown hair. She has got a big mouth. He has got blue eyes.	They've got brown hair. She's got a big mouth. He's got blue eyes.

Отрицательная форма образуется при помощи частицы **not**, которая следует за глаголом have/has

I have not got a sister. He has not got a brother.

Образование отрицательной формы

have not got a sister.

I have not= I haven't

В вопросах have/has ставится перед подлежащим:

Have you got a sister? Has he got a sister?
