

Ambassador (n)	If metal objects clank, they make a low noise when they hit each other
Haunt (v) Clank (n)	the main official sent by the government of country torepresent it in another country
Cialik (II)	If a ghost haunts a place, it appears there often
Strike (v irr)	two metal rings that are joined by a chain and are put on a prisoner's wrists
Match (n)	to light a match in order to produce fire
Dressing case	a thick liquid used for making parts move easily
Handcuffs	a thin, wooden stick that produces a flame when you rub one end of it against a rough surface
Rusty chains	a small piece of luggage for carrying brushes and bottles and toilet articles while traveling
Oiling	a line of metal rings connected together with an orange substance
