Statue of Liberty



The Statue of Liberty stands on a small island in the middle of the New York City harbor. It was a gift of international friendship from the people of France in commemoration of the USA centennial anniversary in 1876. The 151-feet (46-meters) tall monument stands atop a granite pedestal above the walls of a star shaped abutment.



She wears a crown with seven spikes. The spikes mean freedom on the seven seas and continents.



In her left hand she has a tablet with the date of the Declaration of Independence, July 4, 1776



A broken chain lies at her feet. The chain means tyranny.





There is the museum in the bottom of the statue. It tells visitors about the history of immigrants to the USA.

Empire State Building



THE EMPIRE STATE BUILDING AT 102 FLOORS WAS ONCE THE WORLD'S HIGHEST SKYSCRAPER. THIS CLASSIC ART DECO STRUCTURE LOCATED ON FIFTH AVENUE AT 34TH STREET, WAS BUILT IN 1931 AND IS 443 METERS TALL. THE OBSERVATORY IS ON THE 102ND FLOOR. ADMISSION COSTS \$18.00.



Rockefeller Center



The complex of Buildings known as Rockefeller Center is located on Fifth Avenue at 50th Street. It contains the National Broadcast Systems television studios, a large entertainment venue known as Radio City Music Hall, an outdoor ice skating rink, and a collection of shops and restaurants. At the top of 30 Rockefeller Plaza is an observation deck known as "the Top of the Rock".
