He ***always*** deliver**s** letters.

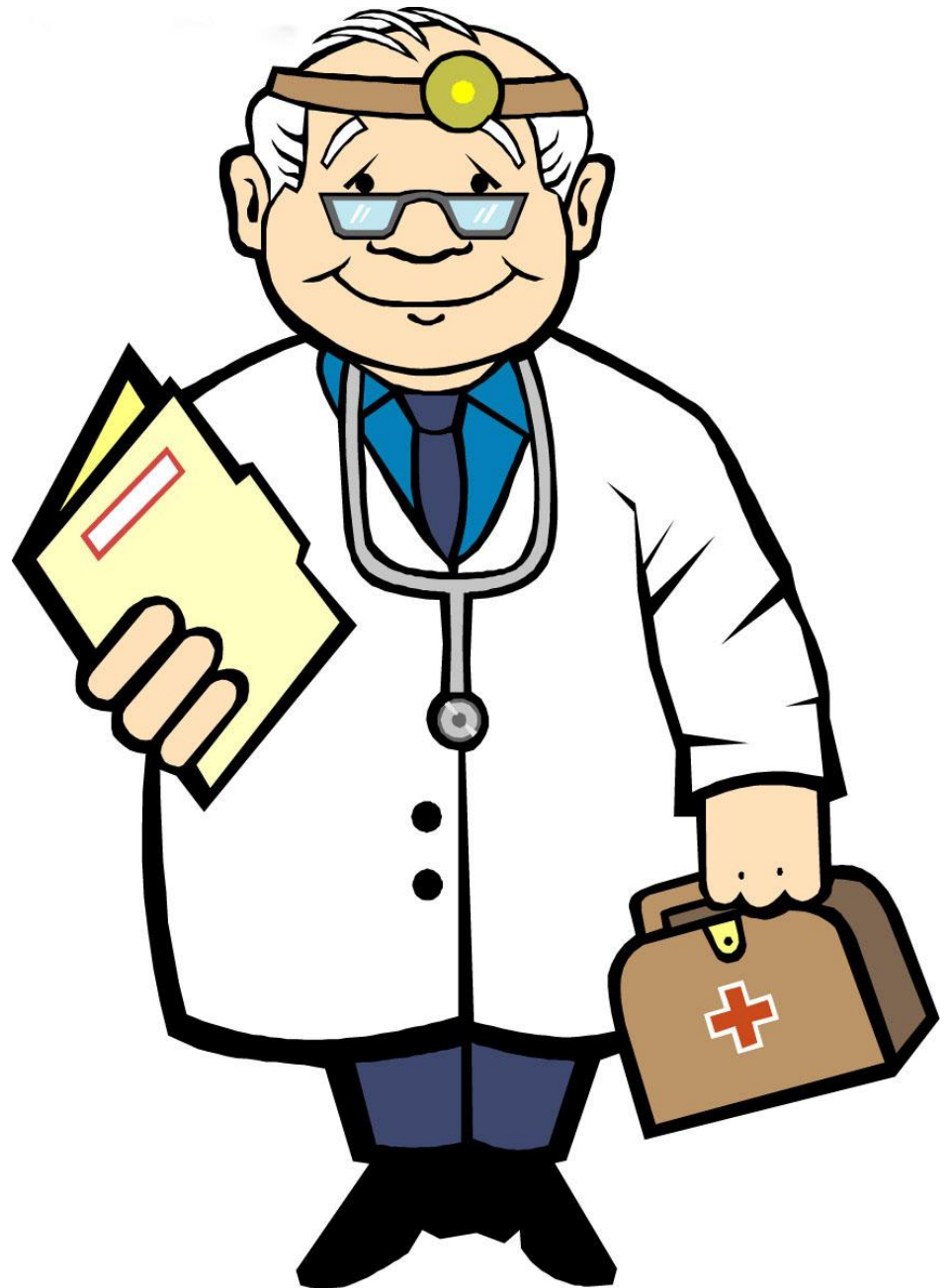
And he **is** deliver**ing** a letter ***now***.

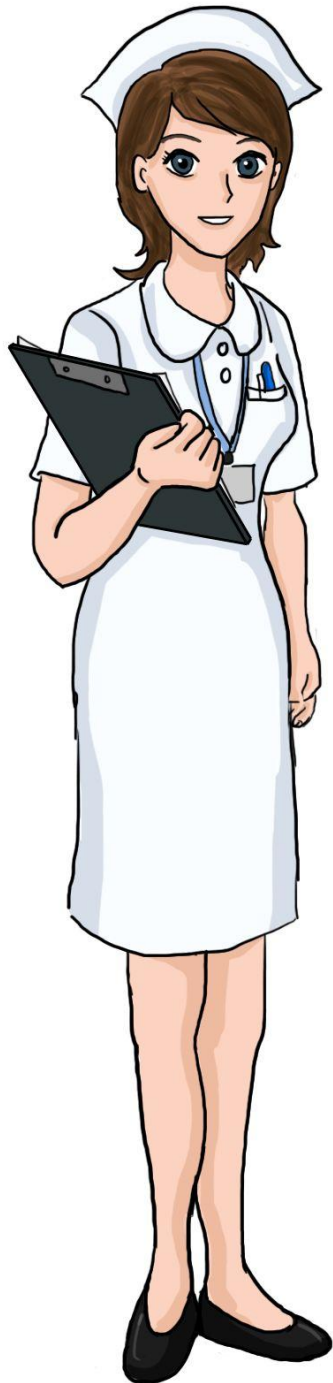


He **is** a

she **is** a nurse

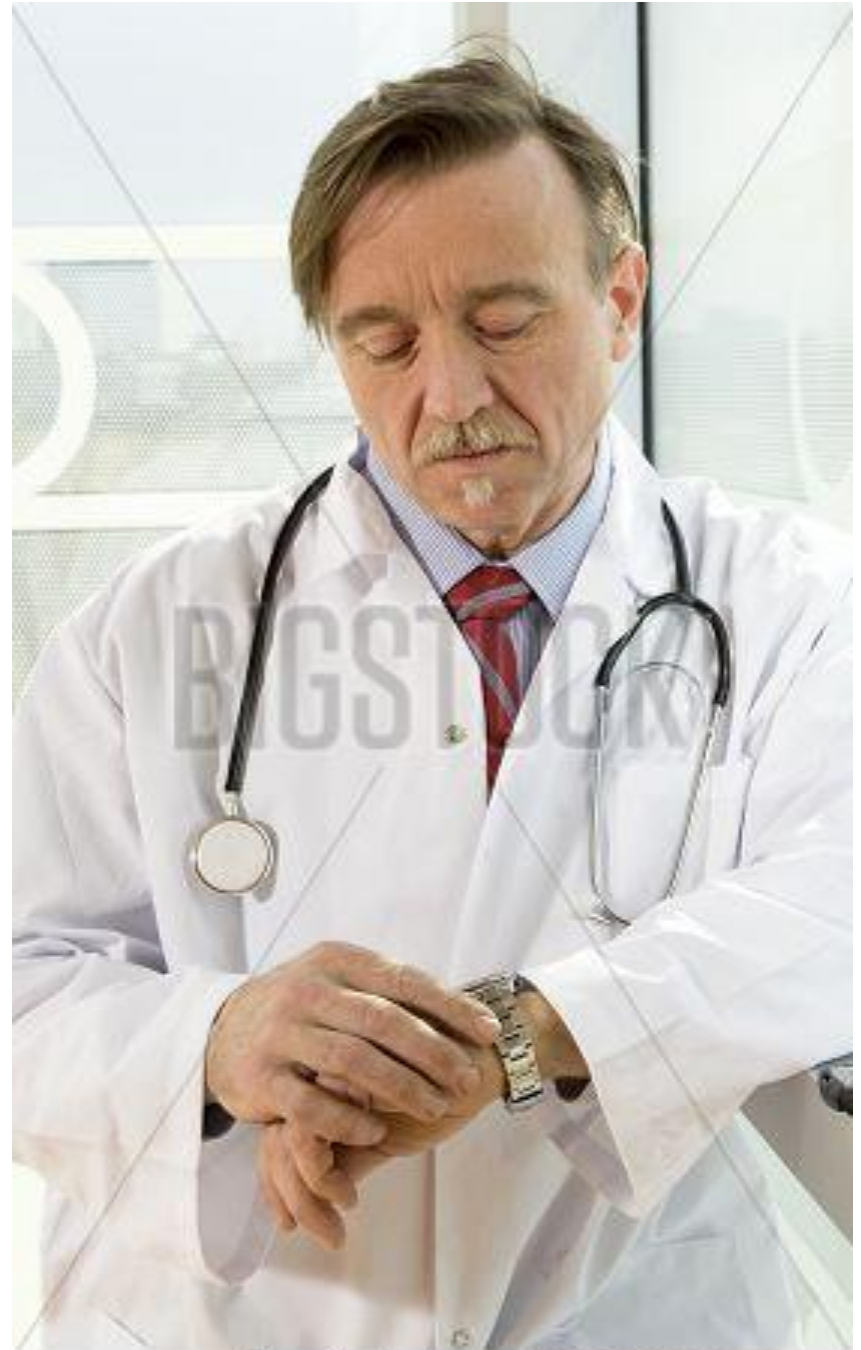
she ***usually*** helps **s**

He *often* flies **s** planes

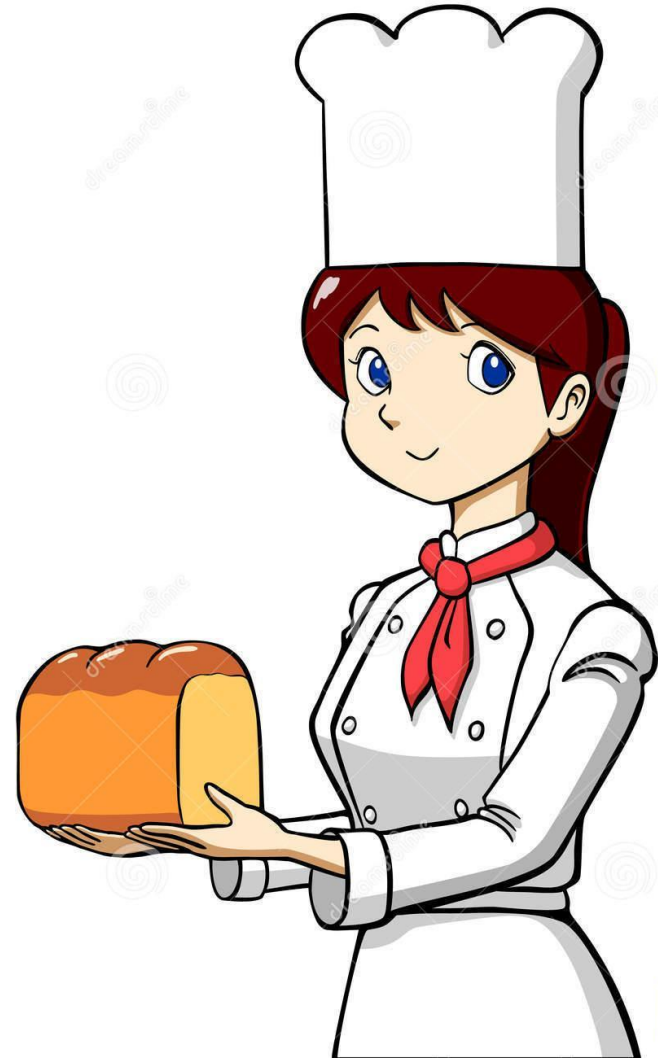


He **is** fly**ing** a plane *now*

**are baking**

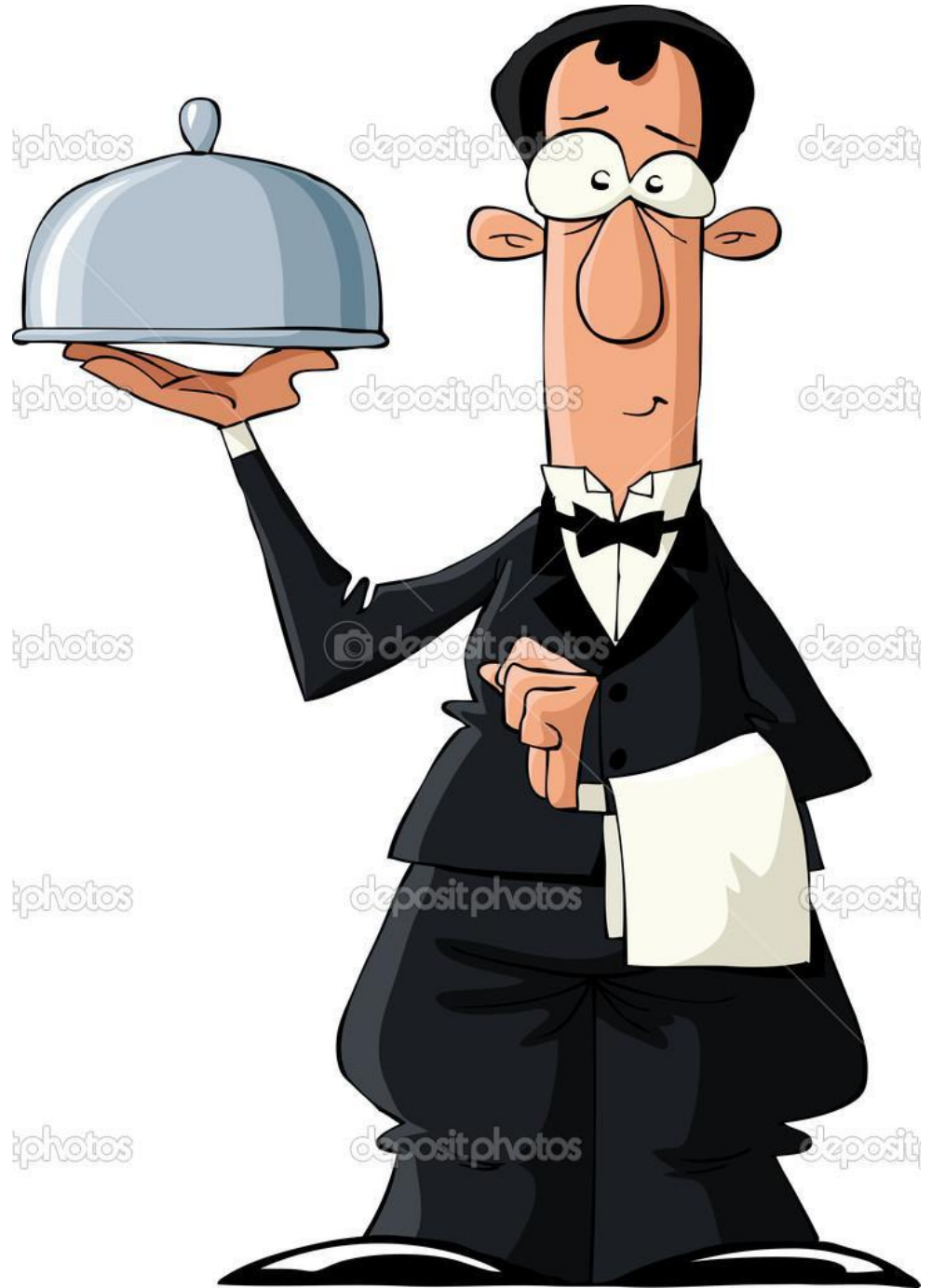


He **is** a waiter.

a drink

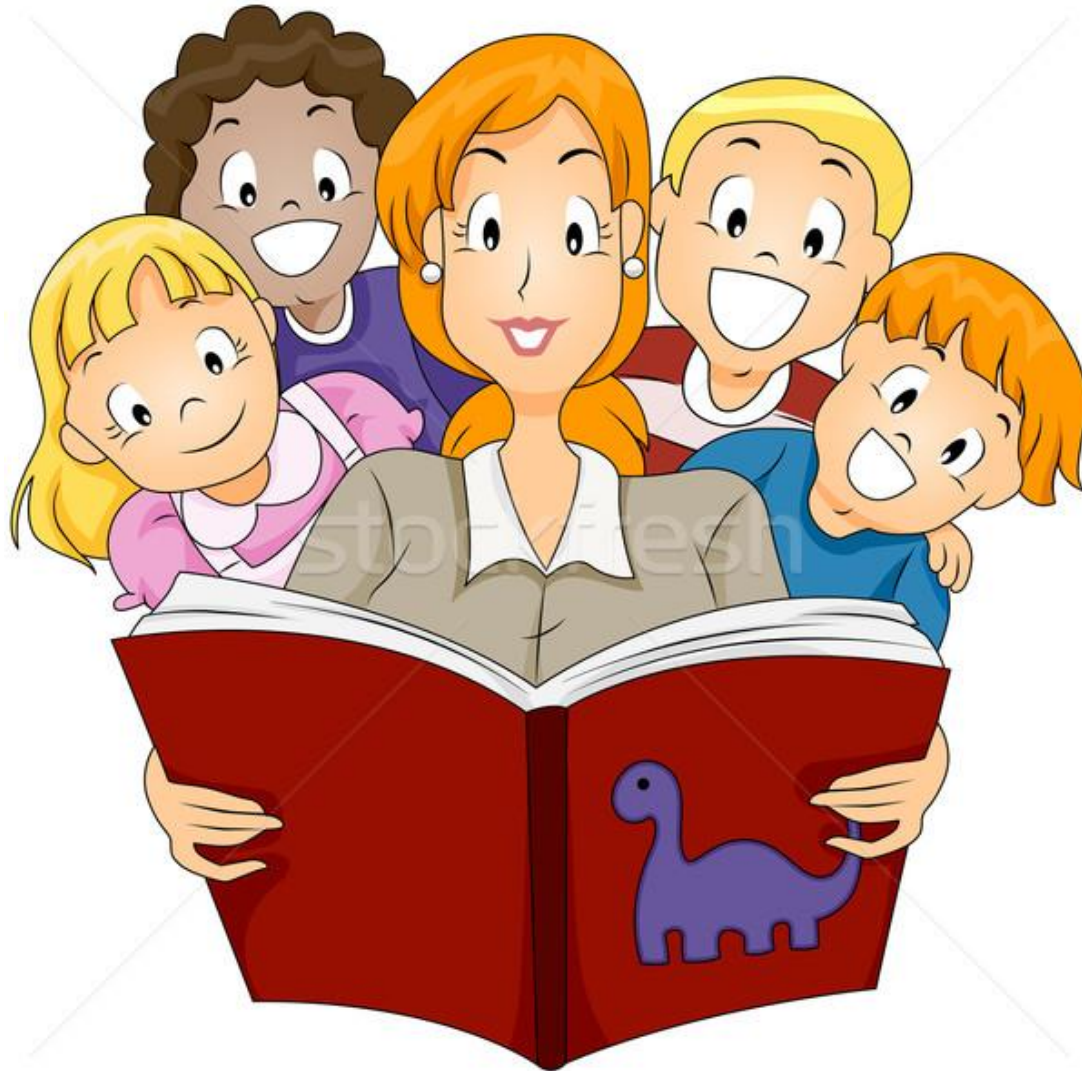


She is a teacher. She reads **s**
