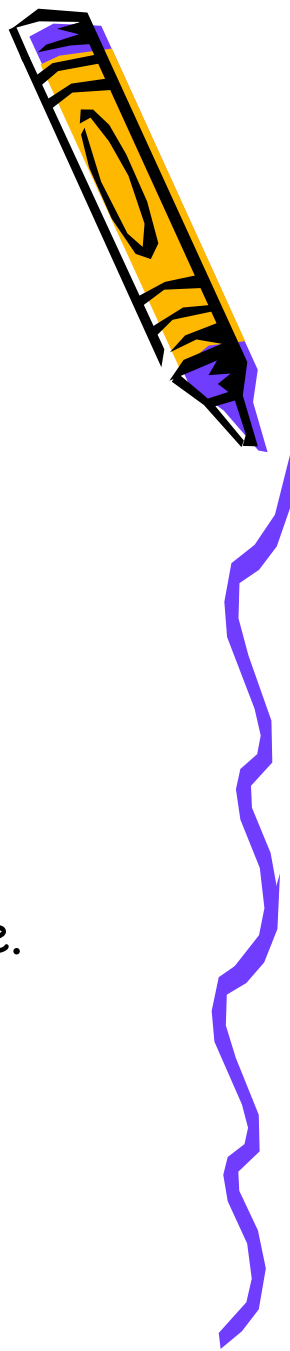


One pound - five pounds - ten pounds.
