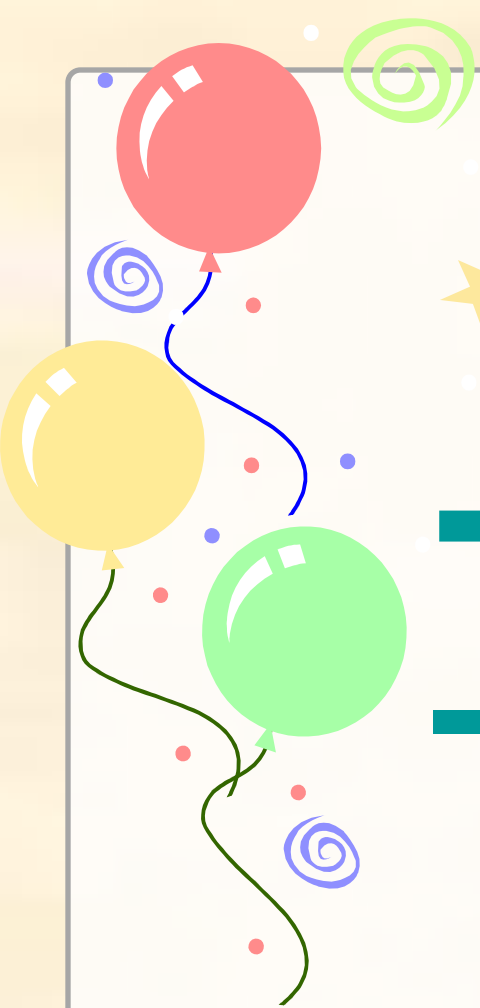


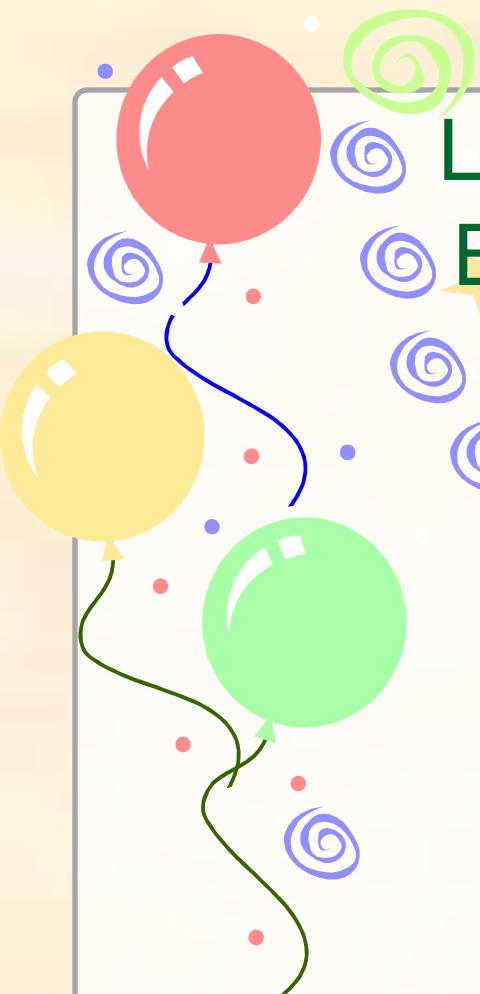

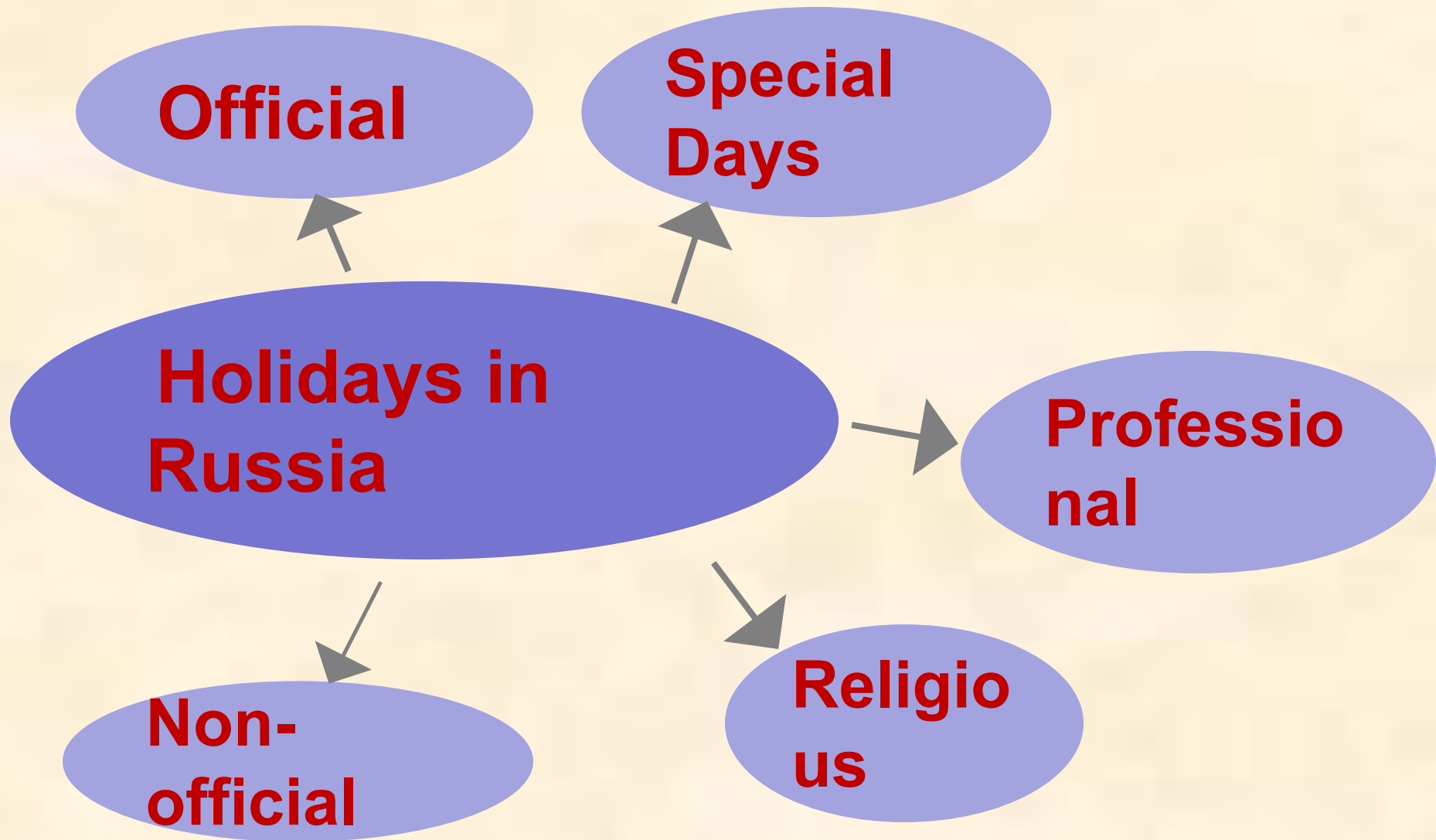

# Let`s do the cinquain


- 1<sup>st</sup> line: существительное-тема
