Types of Questions



1. General question (Yes/no question)

(Общий вопрос)



Это вопрос, требующий ответа «да» или «нет».
Начинается с глагола.

Does she like knitting? – Yes, she does./No, she doesn't.

Она любит вязать? – Да./Нет.



Не забывайте, что глаголу **to be** в настоящем простом и прошедшем времени не требуется никаких вспомогательных глаголов:



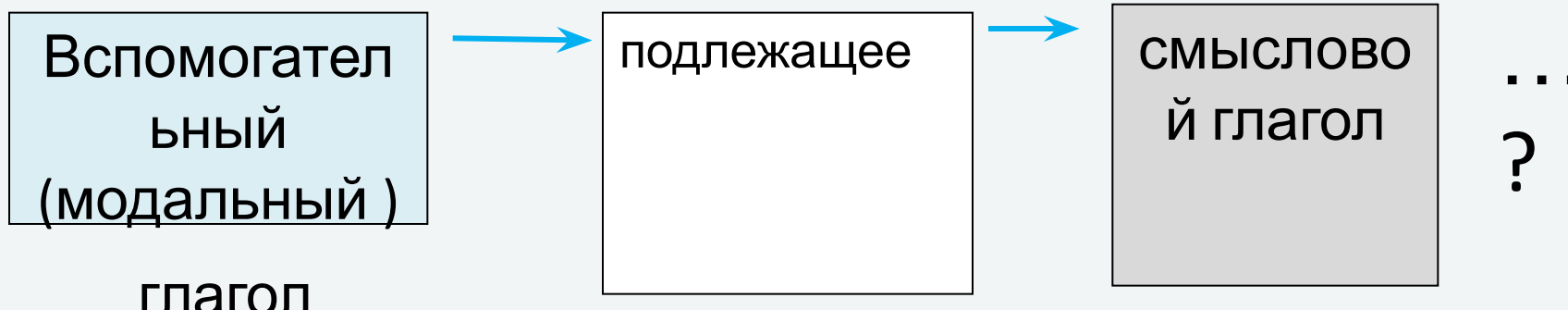
Is this his book? – Yes, it is./No, it isn't.

1. General question (Yes/no question)

(Общий вопрос)

Порядок слов в общем вопросе:

1. вспомогательный (модальный, глагол-связка) глагол,
2. подлежащее (существительное или местоимение),
3. смысловой глагол (или дополнение).

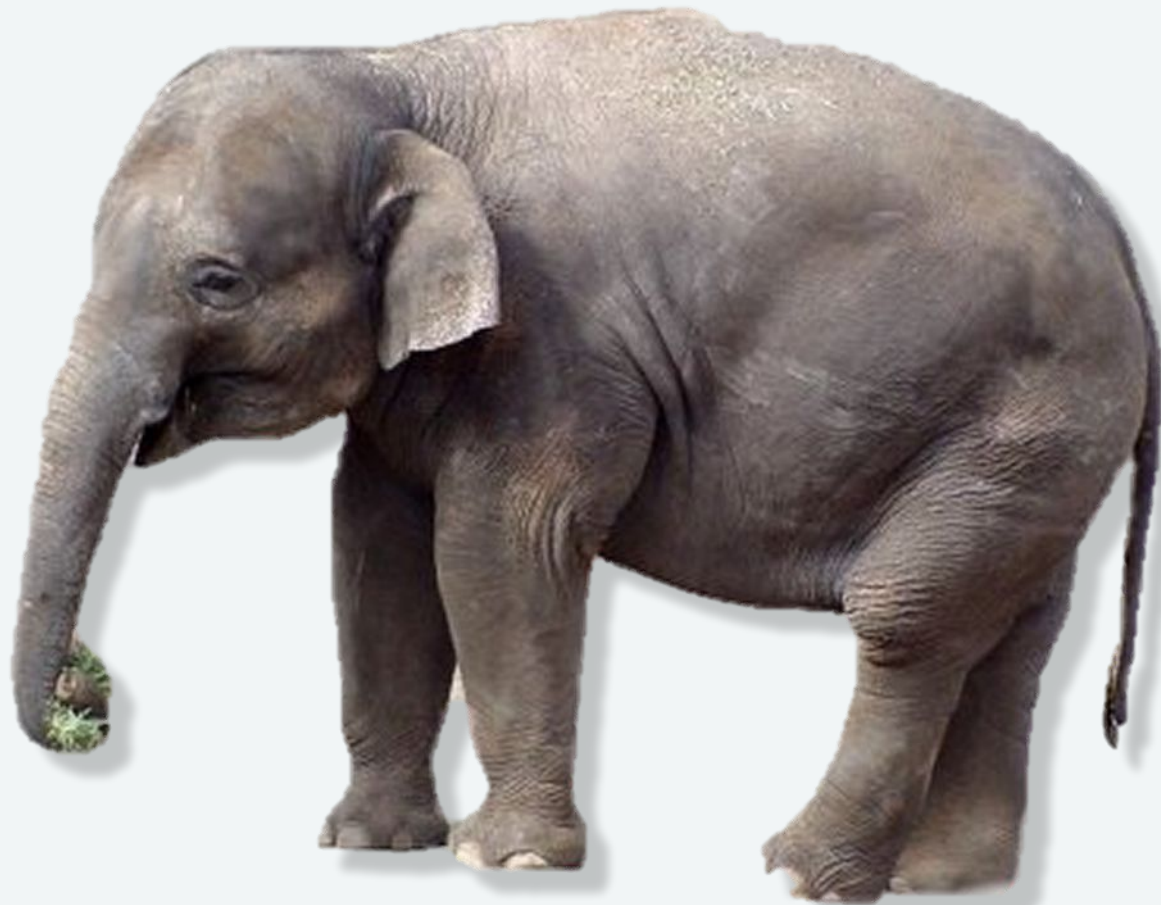

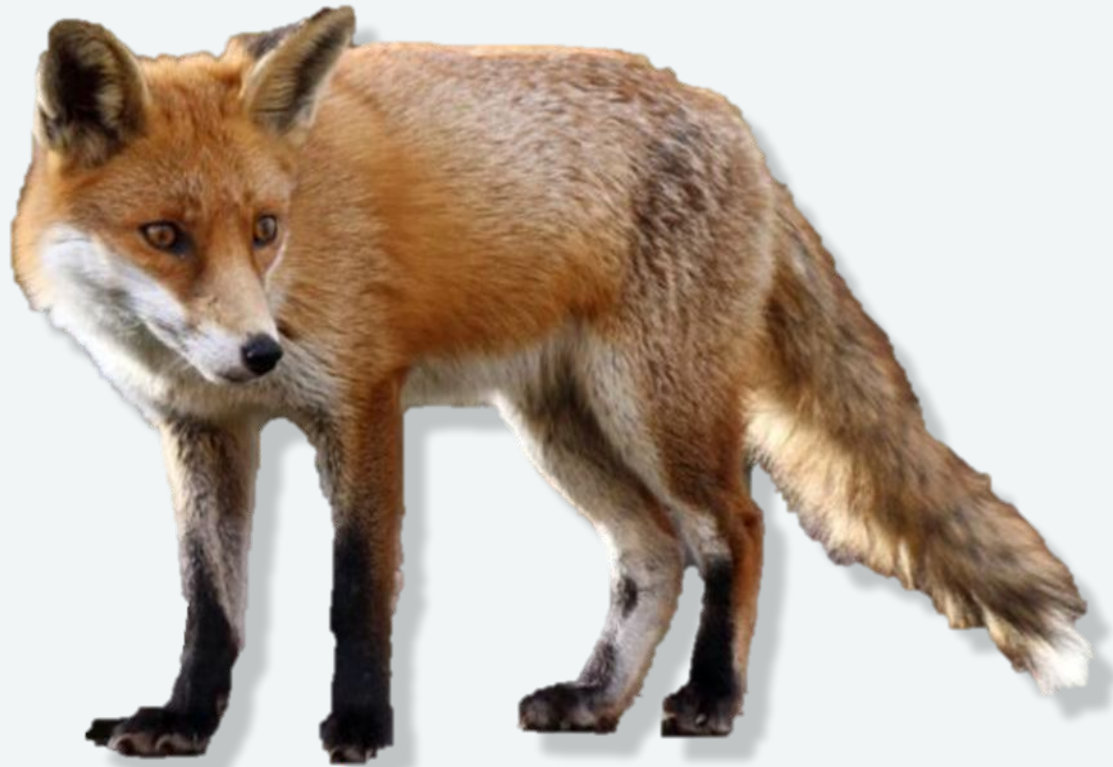
