







Action: Move your arms at your sides, as if you are a train, and say oh, oh, oh, oh.






Sh Tune: Where, Oh Where, has My Little Dog Gone?


Hush! Hush! Hush!

Sh! /sh/-/sh/-/sh/-/sh/!




Action: Place your index finger over your lips, and say shshshsh.
