- игровые упражнения.

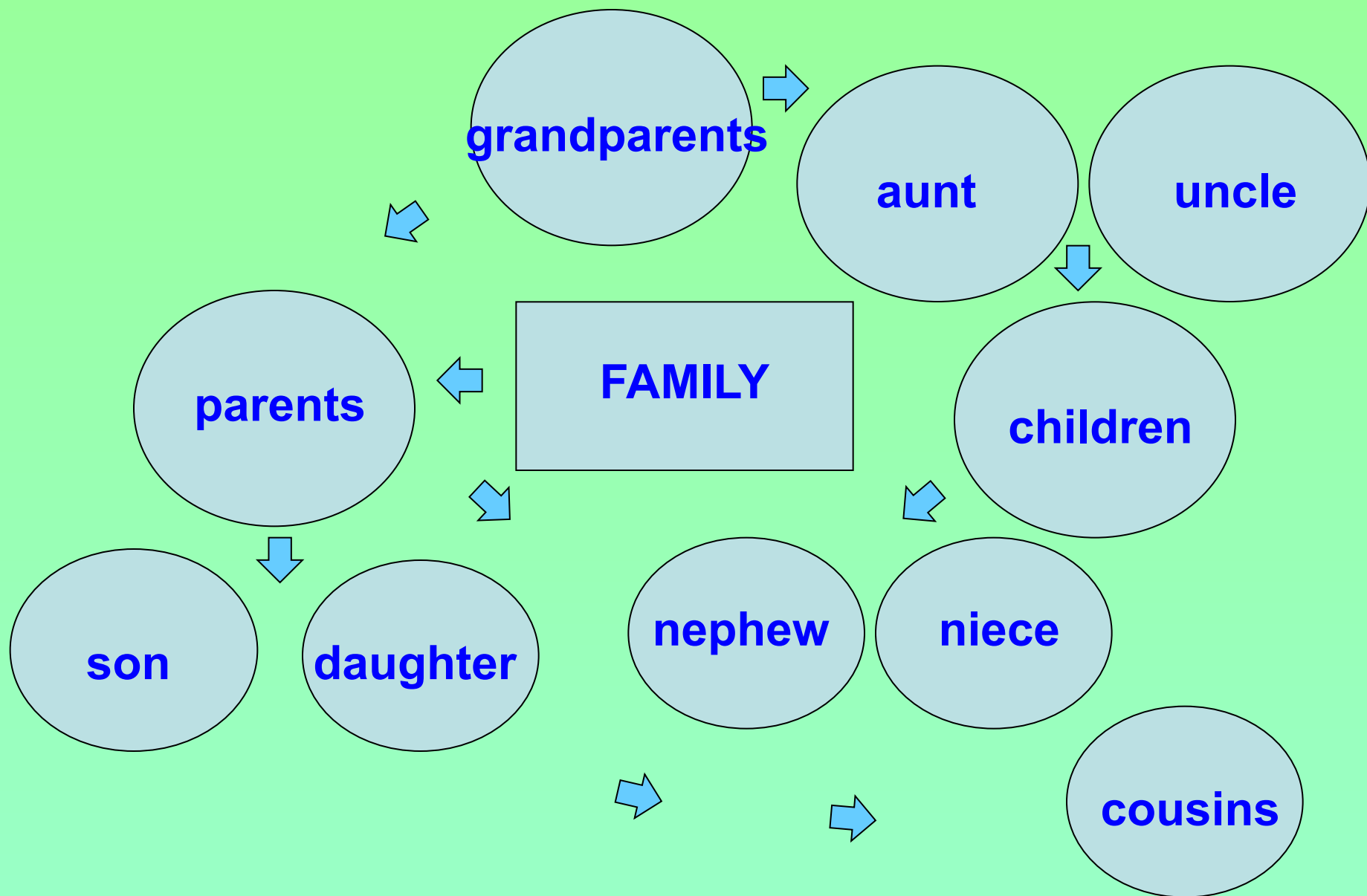

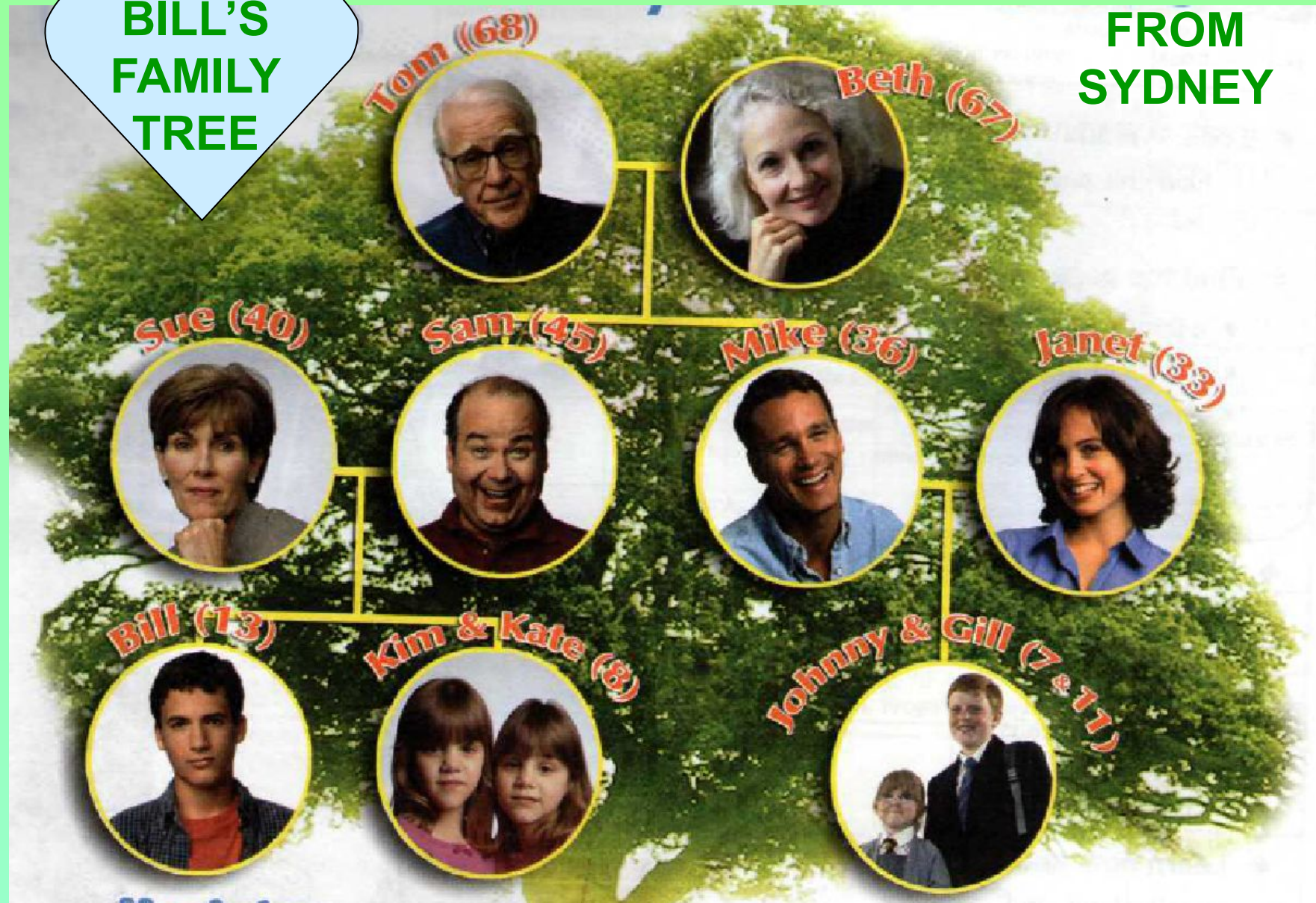
