



A rebus is any piece of writing that replaces words, or parts of words, with pictures



A rebus-style "escort card" from around 1865, to be read as "May I see you home my dear?"

A rebus (/ˈriːbəs/) is an allusional device that uses pictures to represent words or parts of words. It was a favourite form of heraldic expression used in the Middle Ages to denote surnames.
