GRAMMAR DICROVERIES (RULES)

Be careful about the use of “the” with the features of the environment.

We don't use any article with the names of:

Continents: Europe, Asia, North America, Australia

Countries: Russia, Spain, Sweden, New Zealand

But: we use “the” in the names with “Republic”, “Federation”, “State”, “Kingdom”:
the Russian Federation, the USA,
the United Kingdom (the UK).

Mountains: Everest, Elbrus

But: we use “the” with mountain chains: the Alps, the Urals ['jʊərəls], the Caucasus ['kɔ:kəsəs], the Pamirs [pə'miəz]

Islands: Bermuda, Iceland

But: we use “the” with the group of islands:
The Bahamas, the British Isles.

Cities / Towns: Moscow, London, Paris

We use “the” with the names of

Oceans: the Pacific (Ocean), the Indian (Ocean)

Rivers: the Volga ['vɒlgə], the Ob [ɒb],
the Thames [temz]

Seas: the Black Sea, the North Sea, the Baltic ['bɔ:ltɪk] Sea

Channels: the English Channel

Lakes: the Ontario, the Onega [ɒ'njəgə]

But: no article in the names with “Lake”.

Forming adjectives

We use the following suffixes with nouns or verbs to form adjectives in English:

- noun + -ful (*use-useful*), -al (*magic-magical*), -ic (*optimism-optimistic*), -ish (*self-selfish*), -less (*help-helpless*), -ly (*friend-friendly*), -ous (*fury-furious*)
- verb + -able (*rely-reliable*), -ed (*bore-bored*), -ing (*bore-boring*), -ible (*sense-sensible*), -ive (*act-active*)
