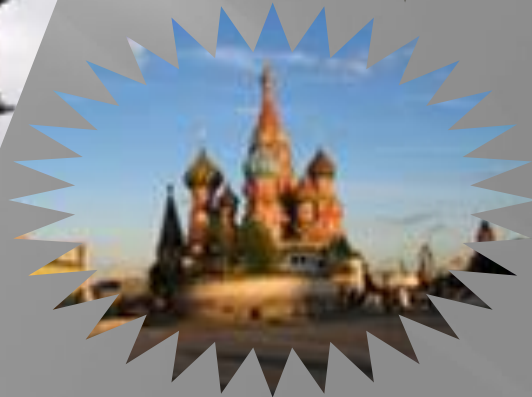
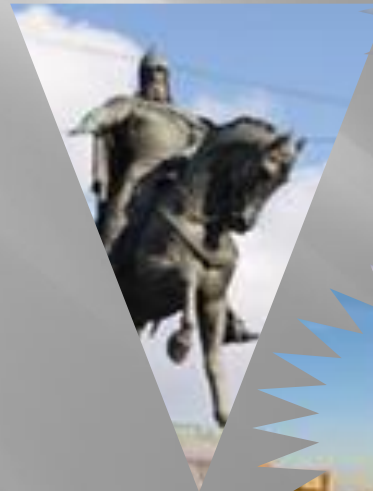
Another symbol of Russia is the birch tree.

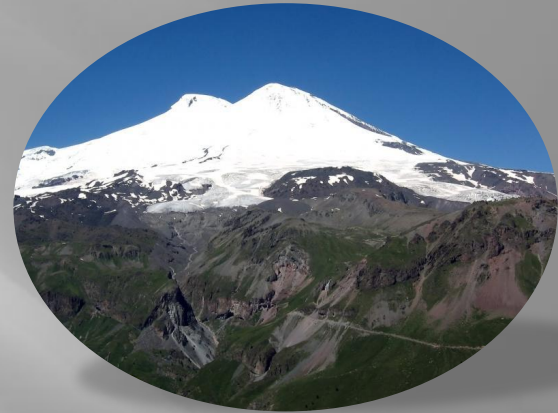
Lake Baikal is the deepest freshwater lake on the Earth. It is 1741 metres deep.
