Before watching activities

Prepare the students for viewing the video and usually involve some prediction work.

Watch the whole

episode.

After watching the whole episode

The teacher should check how much the students remember.

While watching activities

 designed to support the students' comprehension,

 lead them to an understanding of the general sense of the action.

Silent viewing

involves turning the sound off and making use of the visuals on their own.

Description or

narration.

Freeze frame technique

The action is stopped by use of 'freeze frame' or 'stop' controls.

Students are asked what is going to happen next or what people are going to say next.

After watching activities

- comprehension questions,
- completion,
- ordering pictures,
- ordering sentences,
- generating a conversation,
- matching sentences,
- hidden viewing,
- transcript role play,
- story board.
