

## Asking about clothes

### Asking

- ✓ How does this look ✓ You look lovely/great.
  - on me? It/They suit(s) you
- What do you think of perfectly.
- my (dress)? I'm not sure it/they

  Do I look all right in suit(s) you.
  - this? That/Those look(s) terrible on you.

- Do everything in time!
- Dress right!
- Dress according to the weather!

## LET'S TALK ABOUT THE RULES

PRESENT SIMPLE

PRESENT CONTINUOUS



We use Present Simple to describe the action which takes place regularly, every day, usually.



We use Present Continuous to describe the actions which takes place right now.

She always wears boots in winter.

She is wearing boots now.

## PRESENT SIMPLE OR PRESENT CONTINUOUS

- 1. He <u>is going</u> to school now. (to go)
- 2. She always <u>wears</u> a raincoat in autumn. (to wear)
- 3. Angela <u>is eating</u> dinner now. (to eat)
- 4. Max <u>is doing</u> his homework now. (to do)
- 5. Oliver goes jogging every morning. (to go jogging)
