FOR 3 LEVEL PUPILS

EDUCATION LEVELS

- 1 Nursery school – 3 – 5 years old (детский сад)
- 2 Primary school – 4 -12 years old (начальная школа)
- 3 Secondary school – 11-18 years old (средняя школа)
- 4 Further education – 16+ years old (дополнительное профессиональное образование)
- 5 Higher education – 18 + years old (высшее образование)



THE SCHOOL YEAR

The school year runs from September to July and is 39 weeks long.

For many areas the year is divided into six terms:

- September to October
- October to December
- January to February
- February to March
- April to May
- June to July

Some counties in England still follow the traditional three terms a year.



SCHOOL HOLIDAYS



The main school holidays are:

Christmas - 2 weeks

Spring - 2 weeks

Summer - 6 weeks

Registration
