**Developing** – to develop thinking, understanding, memory, oral speech, reading, writing, listening skills;

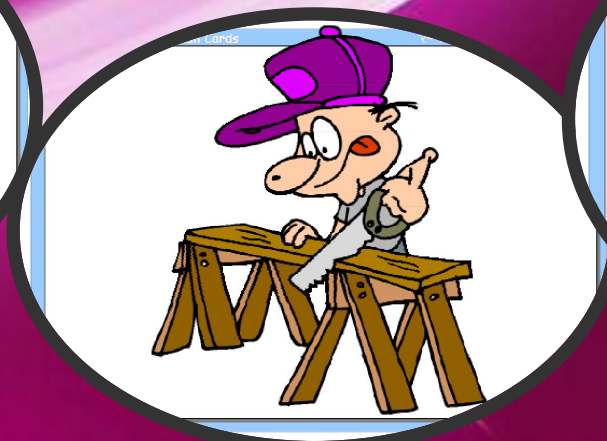
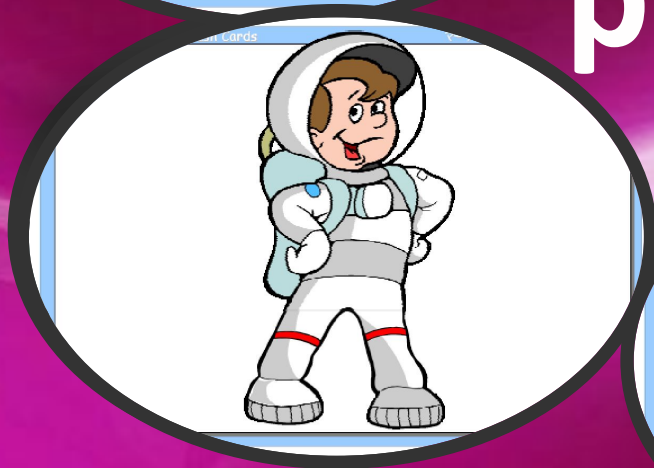
**Bringing up** – to bring about professions; up love and interest to the subject, respect to each other; to help students to choose their professions for the future


