Местоимения

Personal (Личные)

| Nominative Case (именительный падеж) | Objective Case (объектный падеж) |
|---|---|
| I - я | Me – меня, мне, мной |
| You - ты | You - тебя, тебе, тобой |
| He - он | Him – его, ему, им |
| She- она | Her - её, ей, ею |
| It - оно | It – его, ему, им |
| We - мы | Us – нас, нам, нами |
| You - вы | You – вас, вам, вами |
| They - они | Them – их, им, ими |

Ourselves – (мы) себя, сами

Yourselves – (вы) себя, сами

Themselves – (они) себя, сами

Reciprocal Pronouns

(взаимные местоимения)

- **each other** - друг друга (двое)
one another - один другого (много)
- Если вы используете эти словосочетания с предлогами (друг с другом, друг для друга и т.д.), то он ставится **ПЕРЕД** этими словосочетаниями. Именно перед всем выражением, не разделяя его на части.
- **for** each other/one another – друг для друга
- **without** each other/one another – друг без друга
- **from** each other/one another – друг от друга
- **with** each other/one another – друг с другом
- **about** each other/one another – друг о друге

Demonstrative Pronouns

(указательные местоимения)

- **this (these)** – ед. ч. и мн. ч. – ЭТОТ, ЭТО, ЭТА, (ЭТИ)
- **that (those)** – ед.ч. и мн. ч. – ТОТ, ТО, ТА, (ТЕ)
- **such** – такой
- **the same** – тот же самый, такой же

Indefinite Pronouns

(неопределенные местоимения)

- **some** - какой-то, некоторые, немного (утв. предл.)
- **any** - какой-нибудь, некоторые (в вопр. и отриц. предл.), любой
- **one** - некто, некий
- **all** - все, весь, вся, всё
- **each** - каждый
- **every** - всякий, каждый
- **other** - другой (-ие)
- **another** - другой

Indefinite Pronouns

(неопределенные местоимения)

- **both** - оба
- **many** - много, многие
- **much** - много
- **few** - мало, немногие
- **little** - мало
- **either** - любой (из двух)
- **no** - никакой, ни один, нет
- **none** - никто, ничто
- **neither** - ни тот, ни другой, никто, ничто
