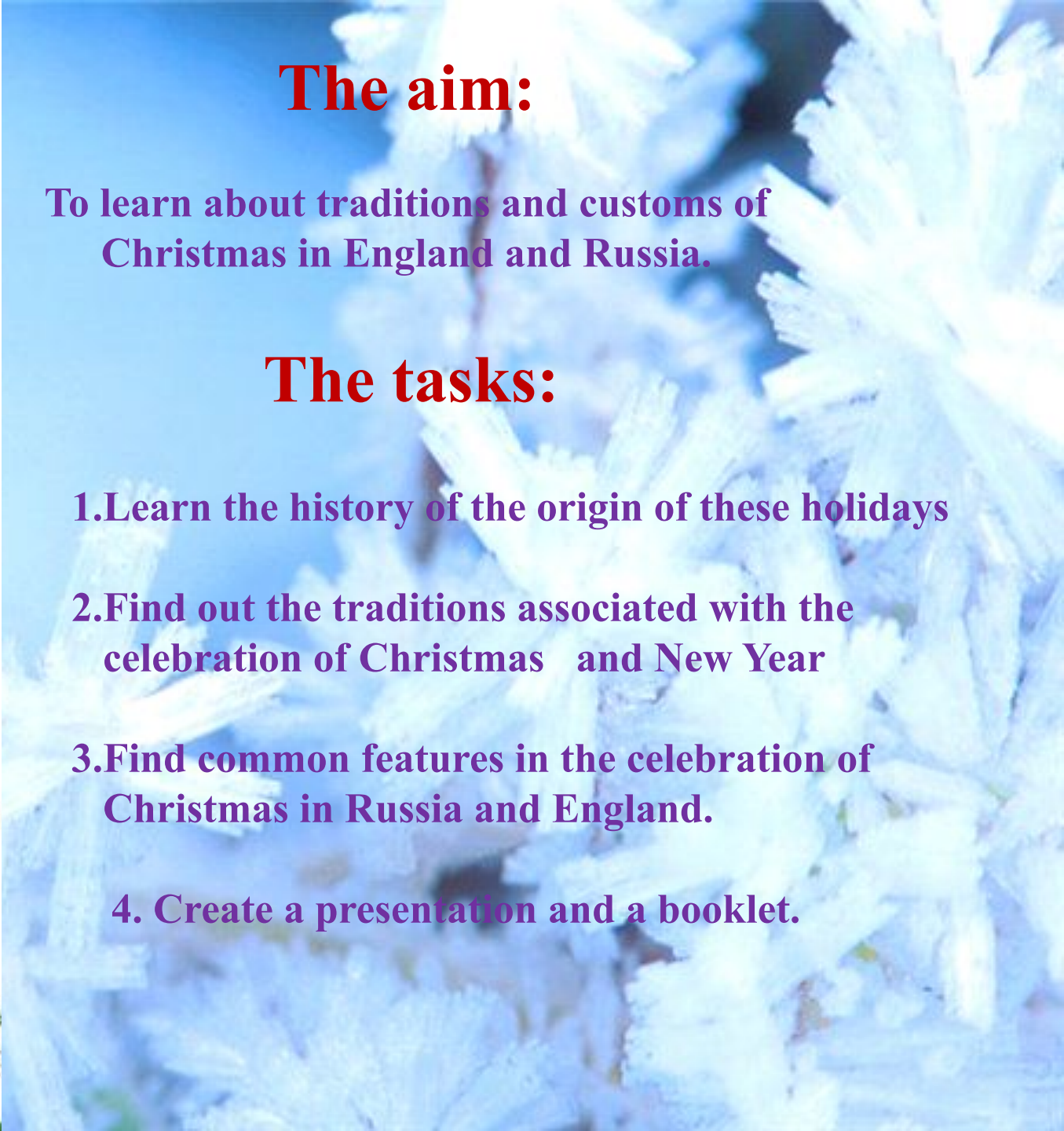


The aim:

Methods:

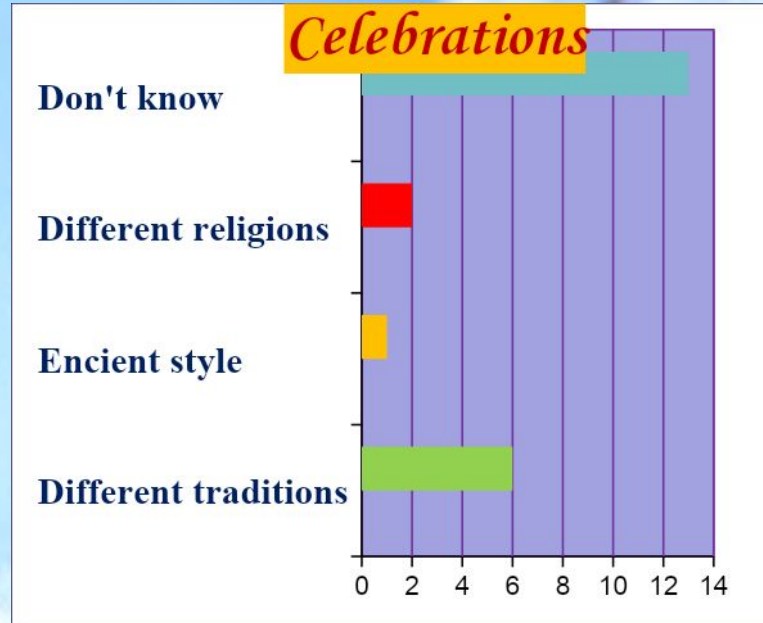
- analysis of the literature;

- translation from Russian into English



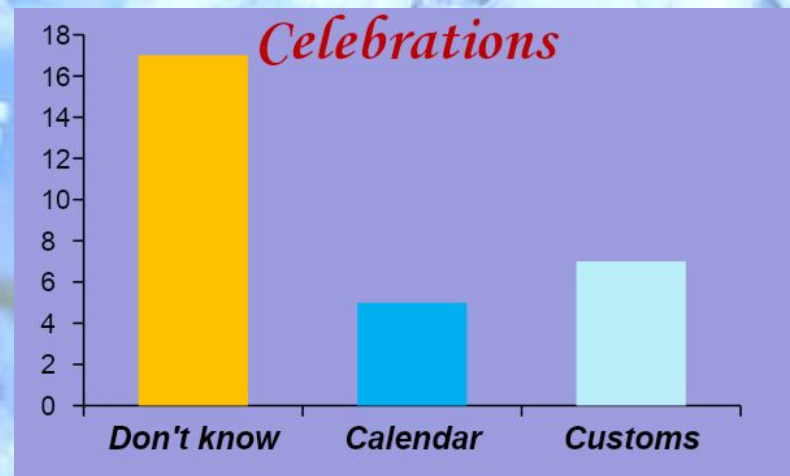
