



Three grey geese in the green grass grazing, Grey were the geese and green was the grazy.























Environmental protection.

The poisoning of the world's land, <u>air</u> (8) and water is the fastest-spreading <u>disease</u> (4) of civilisation. It, like wars, <u>earthquakes</u> (6) and <u>floods</u> (12), is one of history's greatest dangers to <u>human</u> (11) life on earth.

Overpopulation, pollution and energy <u>consumption</u> (9) have created such planet-wide problems as acid <u>rains</u> (1) and the global warming.

The seas are in danger. They are filled with poison: industrial and nuclear <u>waste</u> (2). Every ten minutes one kind of animal, plant or <u>insect</u> (5) dies out for ever. If nothing is done about it, one million species that are <u>alive</u> (10) today will have become <u>extinct</u> (7) twenty years from now.

Air *pollution* (3) is also a very serious problem.
