

## SIDNEY ALTMAN









-James Hillier is another scientist who made an important invention – in 1938, he created the first electron microscope.










-The research work of Richard Taylor has been instrumental in the field of particle physics. Taylor was the first to verify the existence of gluons and up and down quarks.






-John A. Macdonald is the first Canadian Prime Minister who helped to unify New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, and Lower and Upper Canada. Macdonald was a strong supporter of the British North America Act and introduced policies to protect manufacturing











-As a Prime Minister, Alexander Mackenzie created the Royal Military College and the Supreme Court. He built the Intercontinental Railway and reformed the electoral system









-As the fifteenth Prime Minister, Pierre Trudeau strove to liberalize and reform laws and supported the enactment of the Canadian Charter of Rights and the Official Languages Act. He introduced multicultural policies to recognize and promote cultural diversity.
