## Active ENGLISH HALLOWEEN

Halloween is a very popular festival in both Britain and the USA. It is celebrated on October 31, the eve of All Saints' Day.

One of the oldest customs is to wear costumes and masks. In the past, people dressed as ghosts, witches, and other scary figures. Today, costumes are more elaborate and creative.

Another tradition is to carve pumpkins into jack-o'-lanterns. These are placed outside to light the way and to scare away evil spirits.

Children also enjoy trick-or-treating, where they go from door to door asking for sweets. This custom is also known as 'soul-cakes' in some parts of the world.

The evening before Halloween is called 'Trick-or-Treat' night. Children go out in groups, wearing costumes and carrying bags to collect sweets.

One of the symbols of Halloween is the witch. In the UK, an old woman is believed to be a witch if she is seen on the night of Halloween.

The name 'Halloween' probably comes from the Old English words 'hallow' (holy) and 'e'en' (evening). It was first used in the 16th century.

Today, Halloween is a fun and exciting time for people of all ages. It is a time to get into costumes, carve pumpkins, and enjoy the spooky atmosphere.
