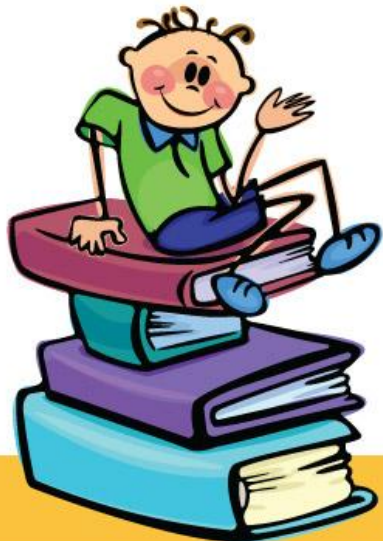

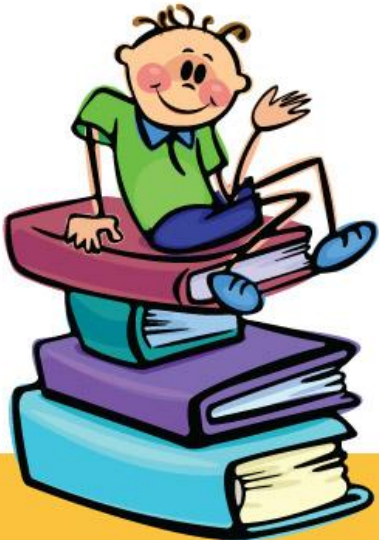

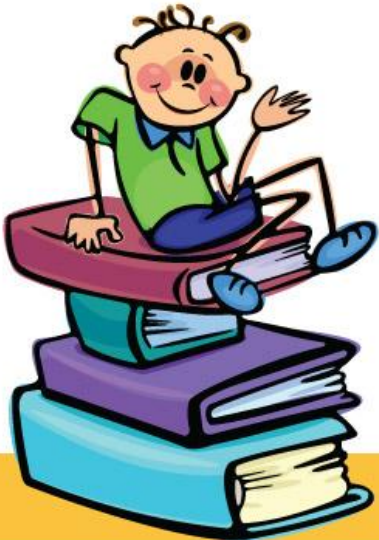

You **didn't** play
They **didn't** play

INTERROGATIVE

Did I play?

Did he play?
Did she play?
Did it play?
Did we play?
Did you play?
Did they play?

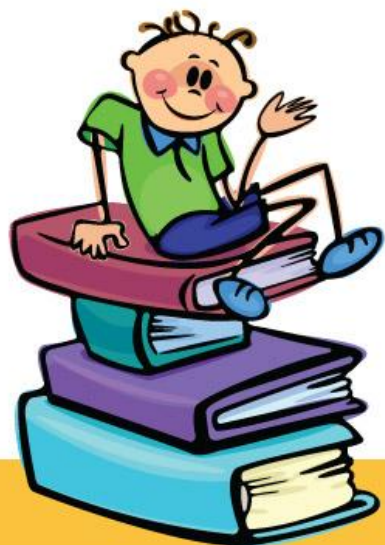

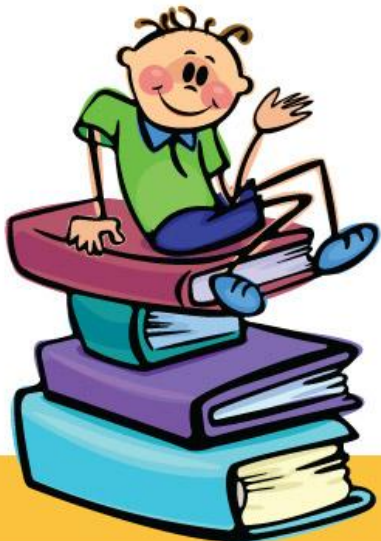
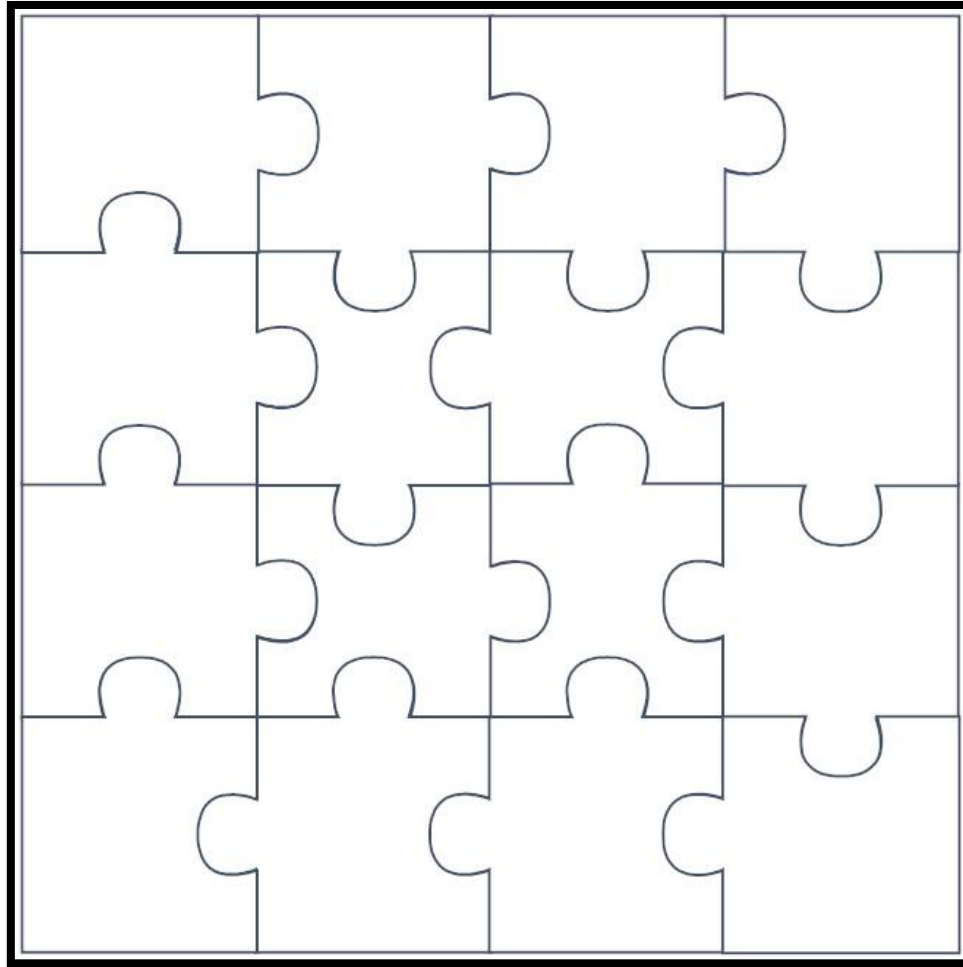
