

The UK is an island state.

It is situated on the British Isles.

The British Isles consist of 2 large islands
Great Britain and Ireland

and about 5000 small islands.

Geographical position



England, Scotland, Wales are situated on the island Great Britain.

Northern Ireland is situated on the island Ireland.

The official name of the UK is the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

People in the UK are called British although they have different nationalities.

The UK = Great Britain = Britain

The total area of the UK is about 244,000 square kilometers.

The population is over 62 million people.

Population is about 7 million people






a centre of the shipbuilding: in this city the Titanic was built




#### The UK FLAG

# BEN NAVIS in Scotland is the highest mountain (1343 m)




### Rivers
