









Famous English writers and their compositions








William Shakespeare

William Shakespeare was born on 23 April, 1546 in Stratford – upon – Avon.

Daniel Defoe

English novelist, pamphleteer and journalist.

Daniel Defoe was born in 1660 in London, England.




Daniel Defoe is best known for his novels **Robinson Crusoe** and **Moll Flanders**.

English author and eldest of the famed Bronte sisters.


Charlotte was born in Thornton, Yorkshire, in 1816.
