Aims: Students master to use the technology;
improve the level of qualified tutoring,
effectively brainstorm and solve problems

Maximum targets:

learn to rule effectively their own ideas

to overcome the confusion, spontaneous flow of thoughts;

in the right situations to be able to separate logic from emotion,
from the actual desired, fantasy from fact

Type of lesson: Solving problem. Six thinking hats



Advantages:

6 different modes, a person may **outline the process of thinking** at any given moment, **based on the circumstances**, guide its development in a better way; **a simple but effective method to become a better thinker** clearly illustrates **the importance to apply ideas** **different views and approaches** do not collide but **coexist**.

What are the challenges?



face in **dealing with any problem**,
the problem situation

Emotions (often we tend to rely on
intuition, emotions, prejudices

Helpless (I do not know what to do,
where to start).

Confusion (we try to keep in mind
all at once).

Features: group think:

- Why **solve complex problems** is often easier to implement individually and not **as a team**. What prevents the best use of the potential of all team members.

The principles of parallel thinking:

- How to **improve communication in the team**.

The concept of the Six Hats:

- **different types of thinking**. Why is it necessary to use all types. How to structure and organize the groupthink.

Using sequences of six hats:

- **effective sequence types of thinking**. How to use the tools of groupthink.
- How to **quickly find an effective solution**, look at the situation **"from a different angle."**

Systemic use of a hat:

- **How to manage group thinking.**
- **Why six hats?**
- **Firstly:** each hat has **got its own individual colour**, making it easy to identify other ones.
- So that, we change the hat, we "I will conduct **the orchestra** of his thoughts", attach them to the right direction
- **Secondly:** easy to put on then to take off. Therefore putting "brainstorming" hat is **designed to help a person attain a calm state, to focus on specific mental operations;**
- **Third,** the "thinking hats" provide a framework for the use of **parallel thinking and avoiding disputes**, time-consuming without any benefit, **helping to negotiate** with someone, **come to an agreement**

Importance:

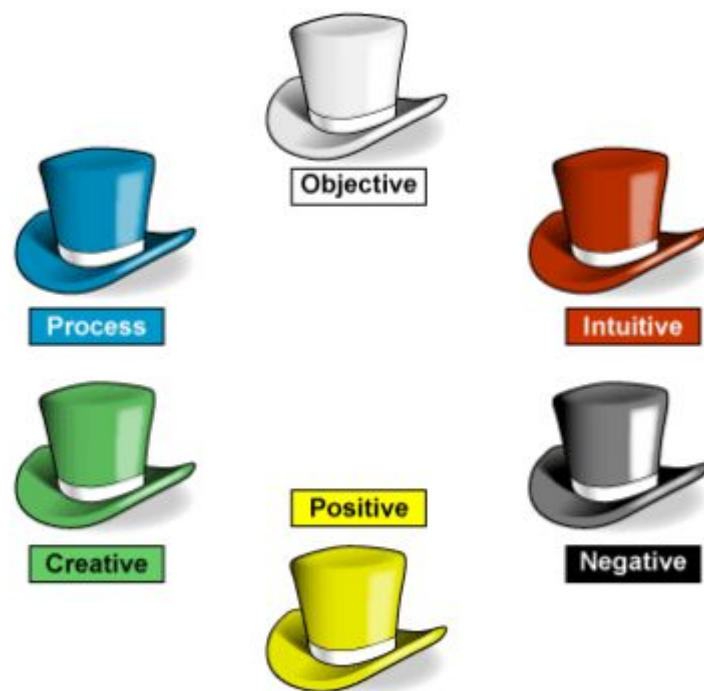
- the method makes it **possible to determine the rules of the game** and learning the rules is **one of the most promising forms of learning**.
- is divided into six different modes, each of which is represented by the color of its hat.

Outcomes:

allows to develop the trainees':

- creative thinking
- critical thinking
- tolerance
