





WILLIAM SHAKESPEARE (1564-1616)





William Shakespeare is the greatest and the most famous of Britain's writers, dramatist, poet and actor.







He was born on April 1564 at Stratford-on-Avon in England. Son of an artisan. At an early age he became an actor and then a playwright in London.




HE SET UP HIS OWN THEATRE «THE GLOBE».


Shakespeare wrote 37 plays, 154 sonnets, tragedies, comedies, tragicomedies


















At the end of the life Shakespeare returned to his home in the town of Stratford-upo n-Avon, where he died.



His work-the highest peak of the art world, it has had a huge impact on the world of theater and the whole culture of mankind.








Thomas Moore

Rise of the "United Irishmen" in the same year in 1803 and the execution of his friend's student years R.Emmeta Moore made a passionate patriot of Ireland.




1819-1822 he lived in Europe. In 1811 he married the Irish actress Elizabeth Dyke.



Moore died in a cottage near-Sloperton Bonvuda (Wiltshire)








Robert Burns




The literary English and Scottish dialect in which his mother sang songs and his aunt told tales of horror about witches influenced Robert's character and his work.






Burns started writing poems at the age 17. He composed verses to the melodies of old folk-song. His life was full of events.






He is widely regarded as the national poet of Scotland, and is celebrated worldwide. He is the best known of the poets who have written in the Scots language, although much of his
