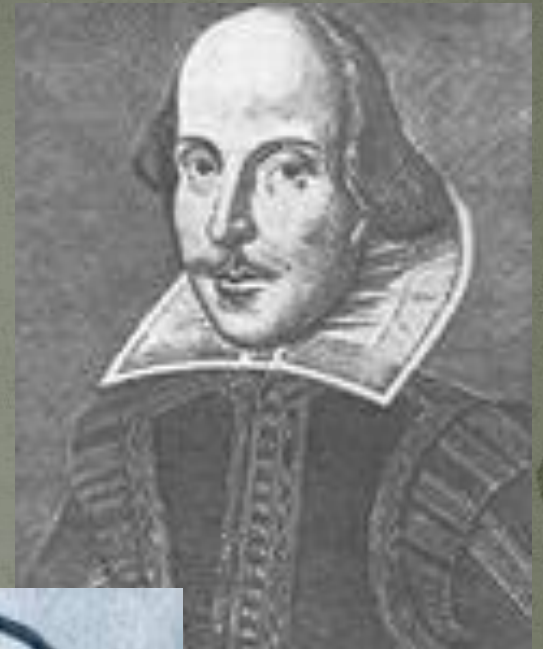




At the end of

- His work-the highest peak of the art world, it has had a huge impact on the world of theater and the whole culture of mankind.



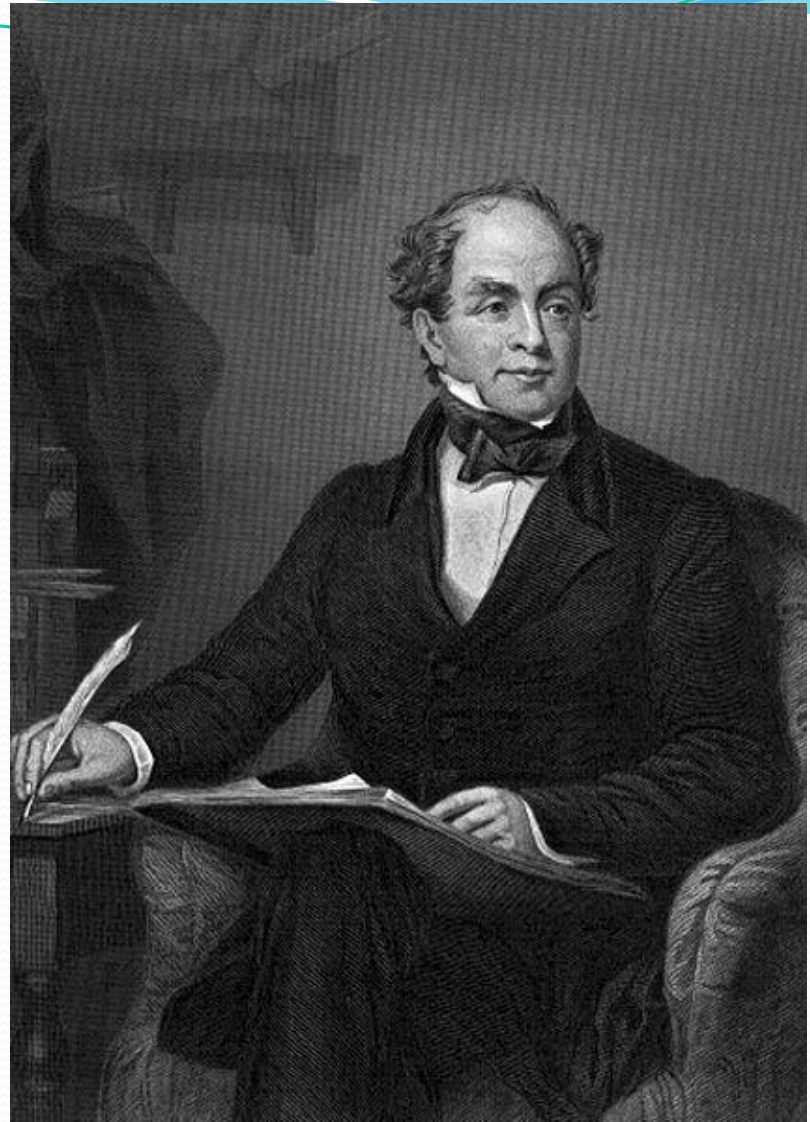






Thomas Moore

Elizabeth Dyke.



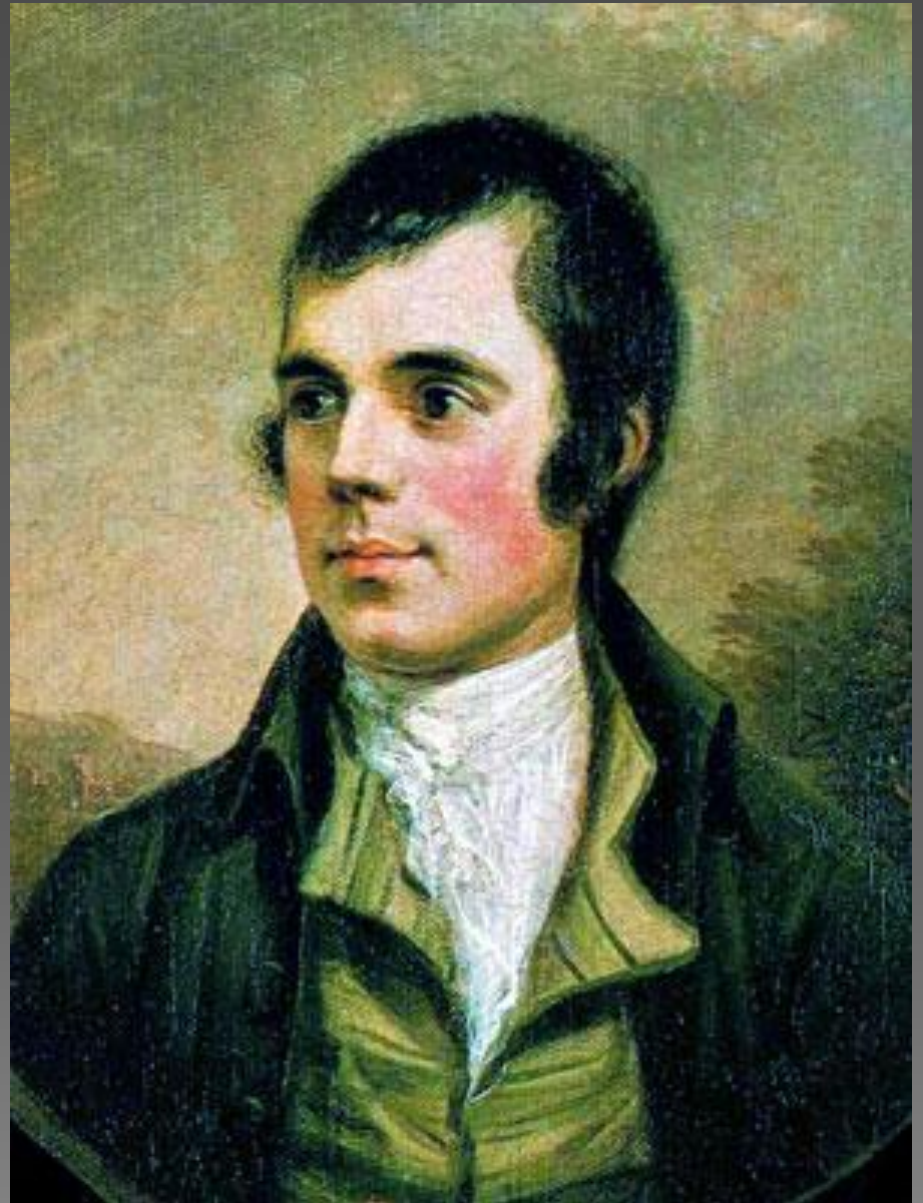

Robert Burns

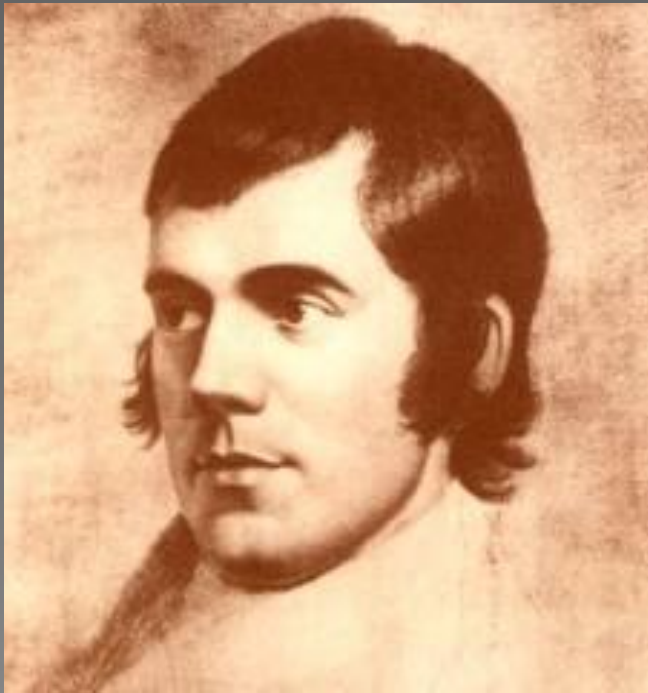
**Robert Burns,

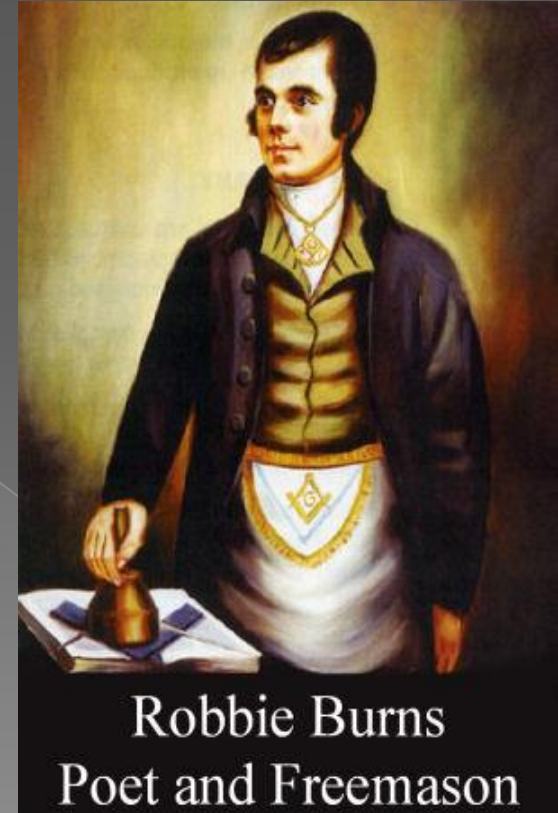
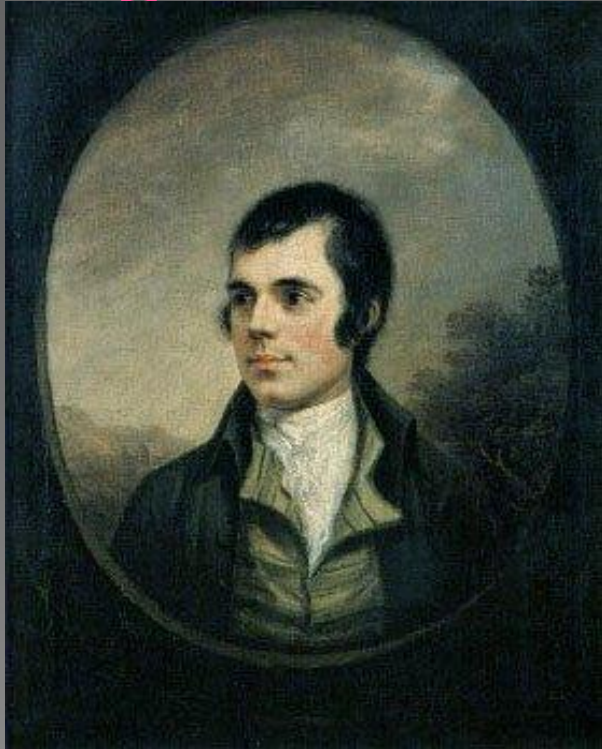
The literary English and Scottish dialect in which his mother sang songs and his aunt told tales of horror about witches influenced Robert's character and his work.
