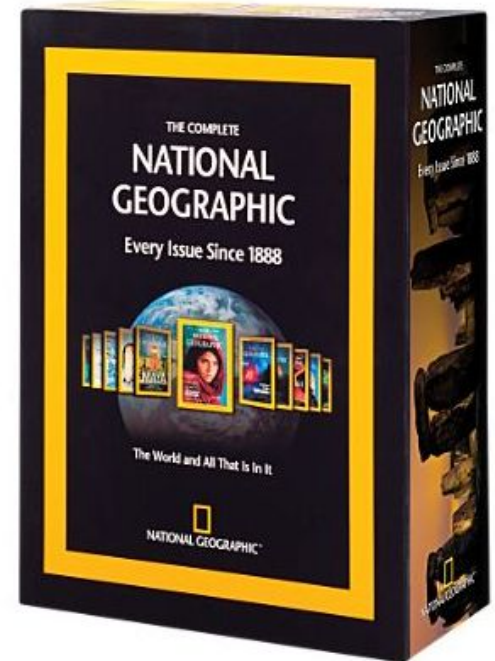
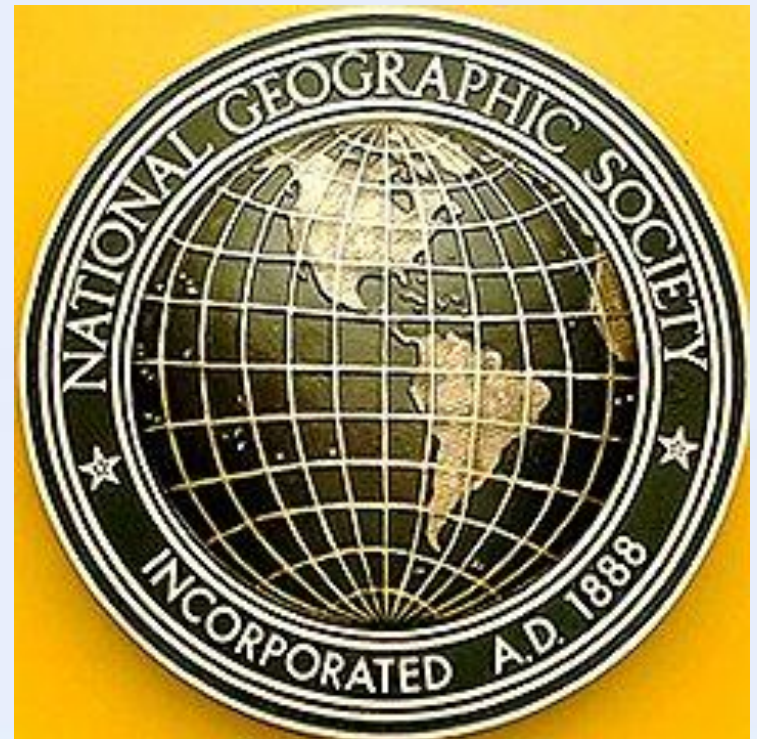

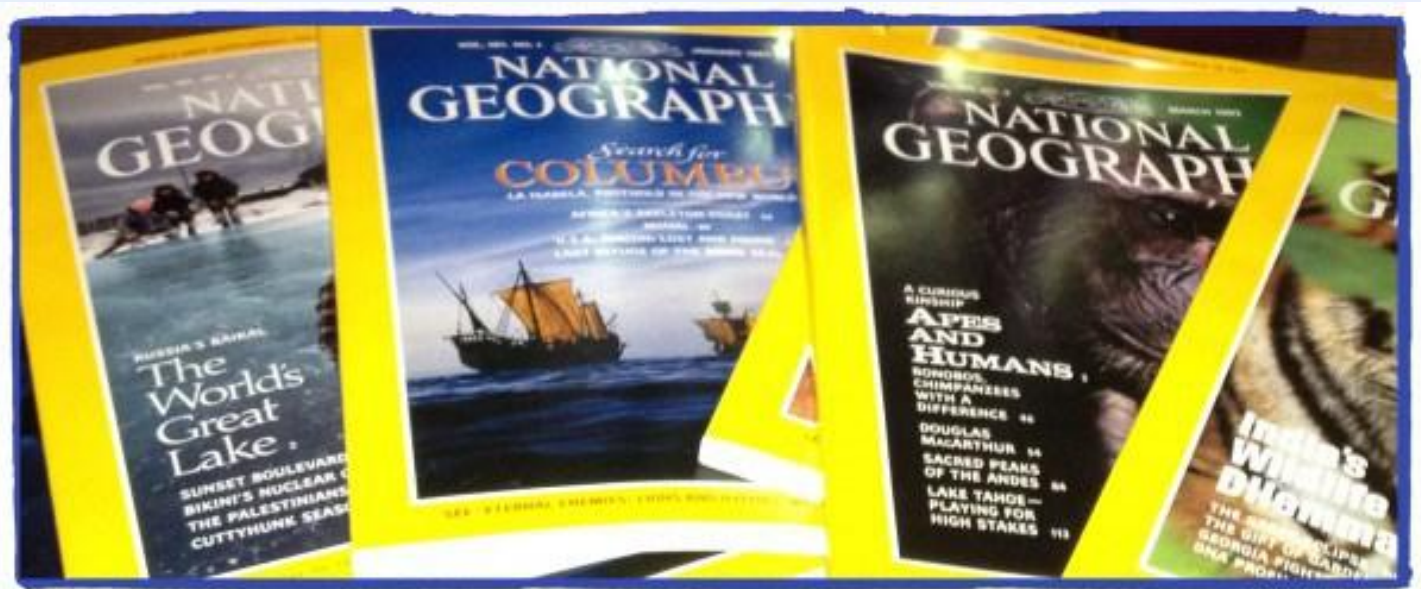
By 2011, the magazine was

endangered species.*

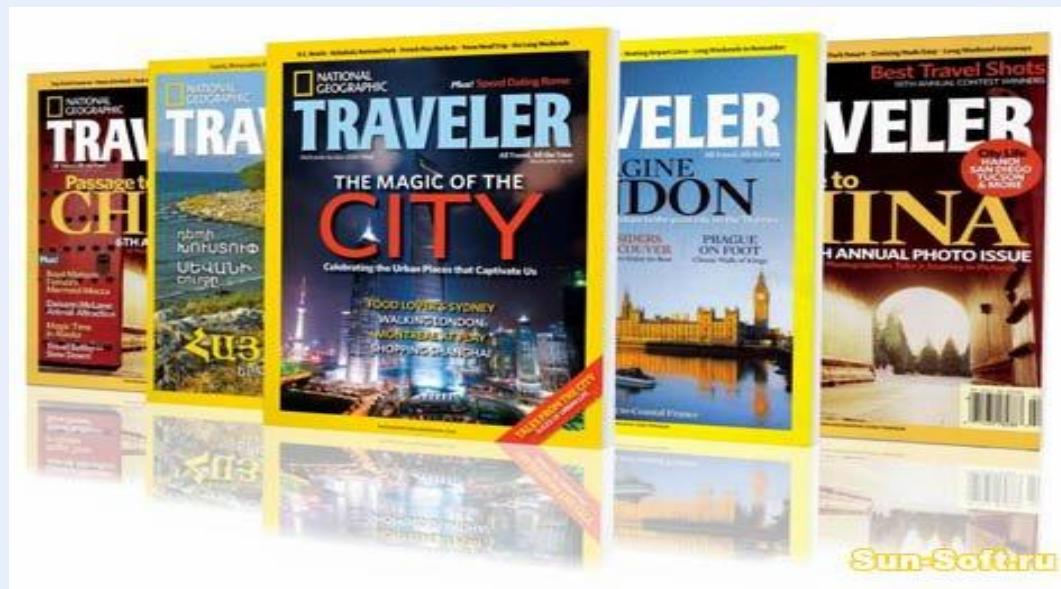


**Series of articles were included
