

It primarily contains articles about geography, history, and world culture.


By 2011, the magazine was circulated worldwide in thirty-six language editions



The current Editor-in-Ch ief of the National Geographic Magazine is Chris Johns.



Starting with its January 1905 publication the magazine changed from being a text-oriented publication closer to a scientific journal to featuring extensive pictorial content, and became well-known for this style.



In later years articles became outspoken on issues such as:

environment, deforestation, chemical pollution, global warming, endangered species.


Series of articles were included focusing on the history and varied uses of specific products



such as:

a single metal, gem, food crop,

agricultural product, an archaeological discovery. Occasionally an entire month's issue would be devoted to a single country, past civilization, a natural resource whose future is endangered, or other theme



On May 1, 2008, National Geographic won three National Magazine Awards—an award
