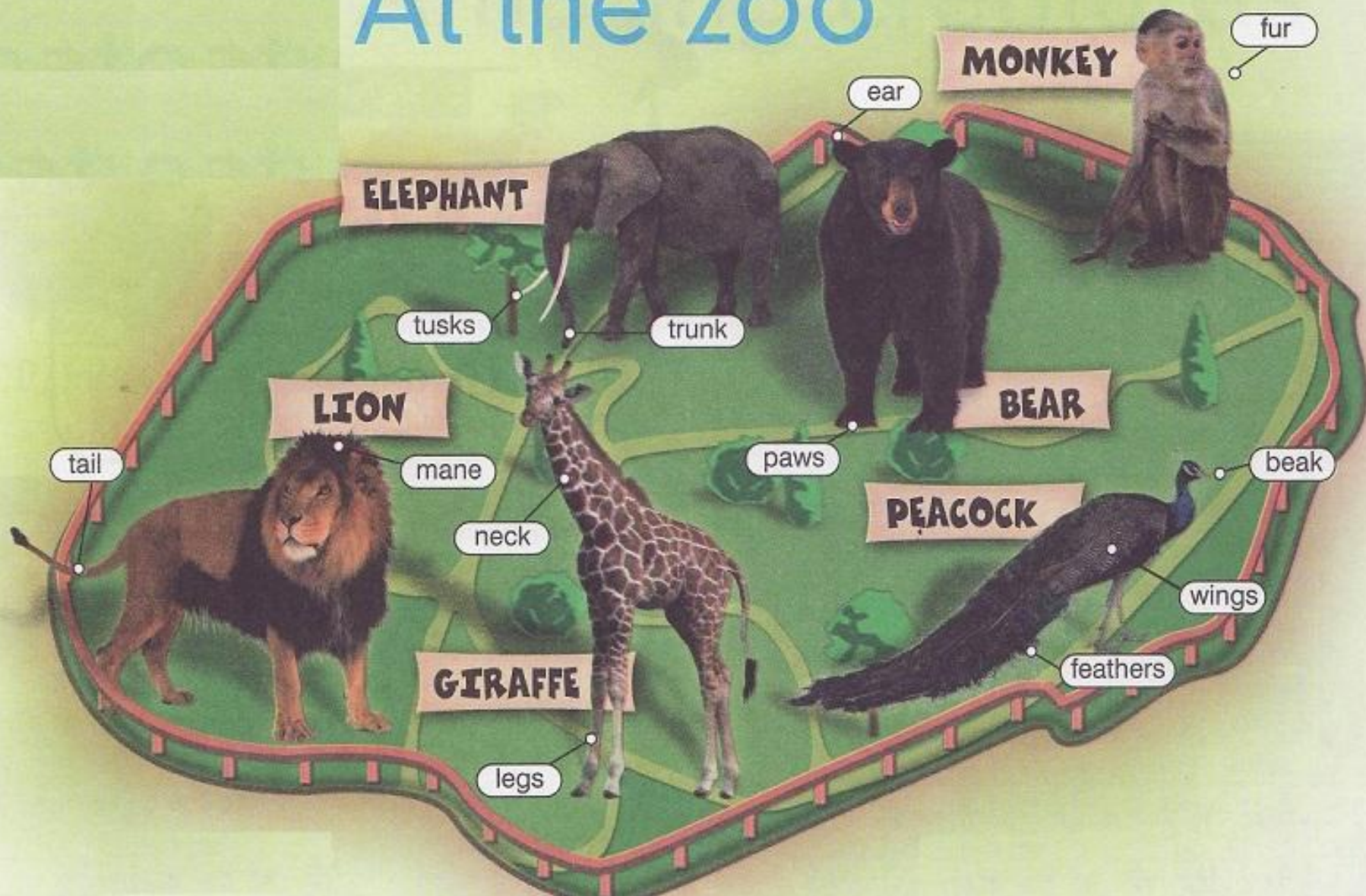

*We use the Present Simple for:*

- . **daily routines**      You always have lunch at 1.30 p.m.*
- . **repeated actions**      He goes to the swimming pool on Sundays.*
- . **habits**      We have coffee in the morning.*
- . **timetables/ programmes (in future meaning)**      The film starts at 5p.m.*
- . **permanent states**      They live in Russia.*
- . **laws of nature**      The sun rises in the east.*

<b>Affirmative</b>	<b>Negative</b>	<b>Interrogative</b>
I work.	I <b>don't</b> work.	<b>Do</b> I work?
He	He	he
She works.	She <b>doesn't</b> work.	<b>Does</b> she work?
It	It	it
We	We	we
You work.	You <b>don't</b> work.	<b>Do</b> you work?
They	They	they
