

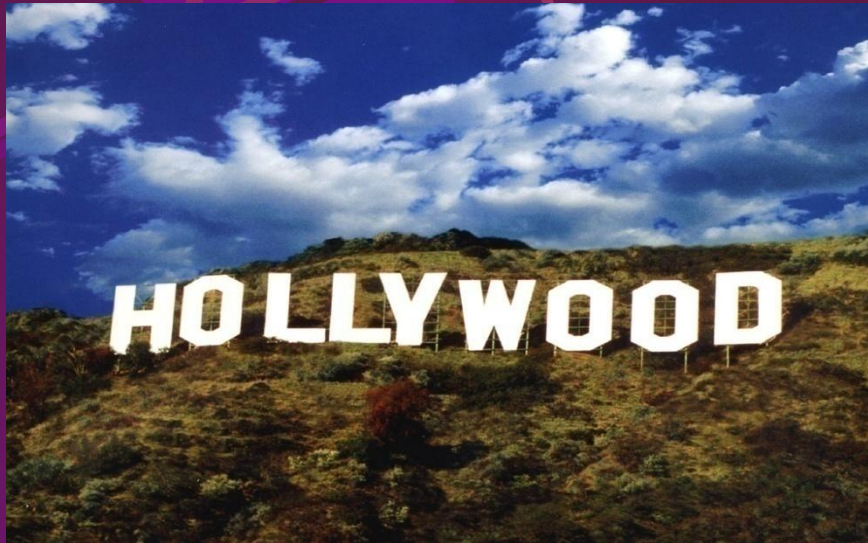

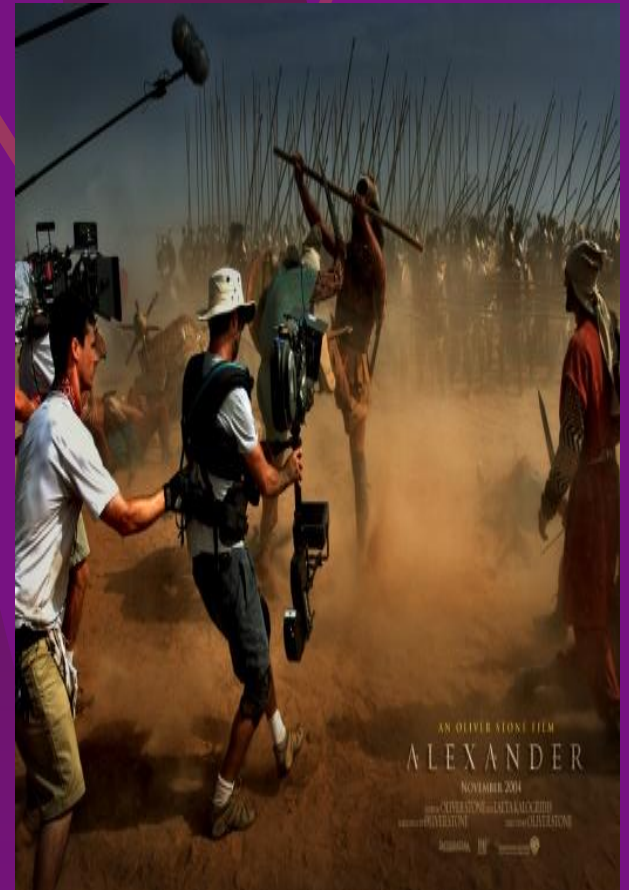

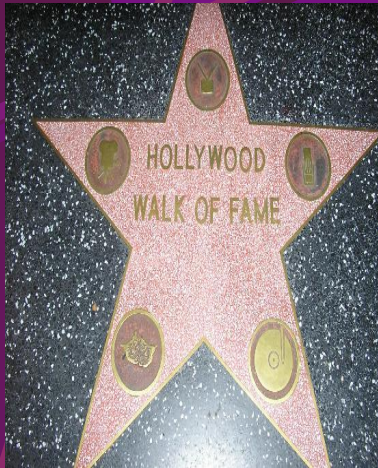

Cinemas in London

In London there are a lot of cinemas and cinema clubs. Some of them show a large number of continental films. Cinema-going is a regular habit for many people in London; the number of cinema-goers is much larger than that of theatre-goers.
