- lovely figure ?

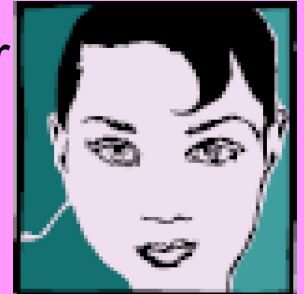

Does she have

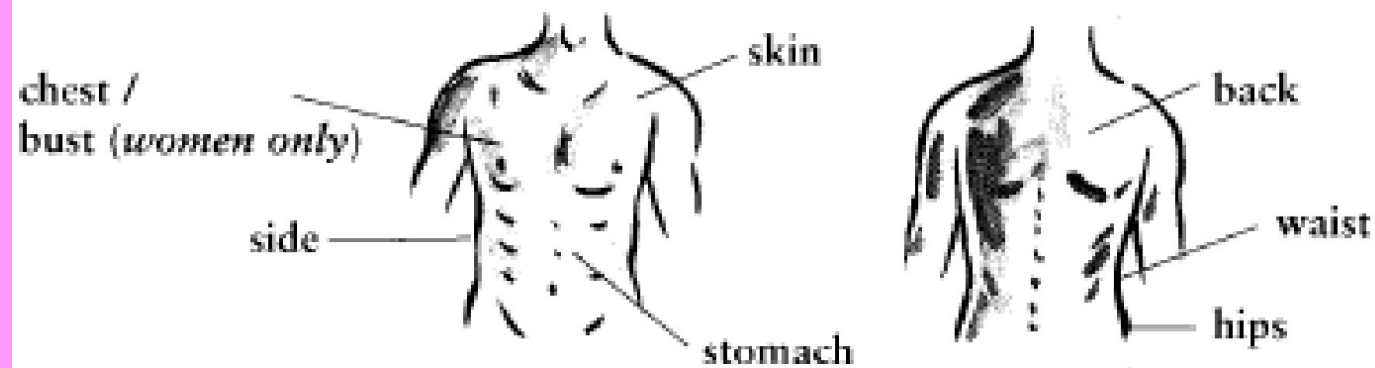
- round / oval / square / heart shaped face

- long / short / shoulder-length ?



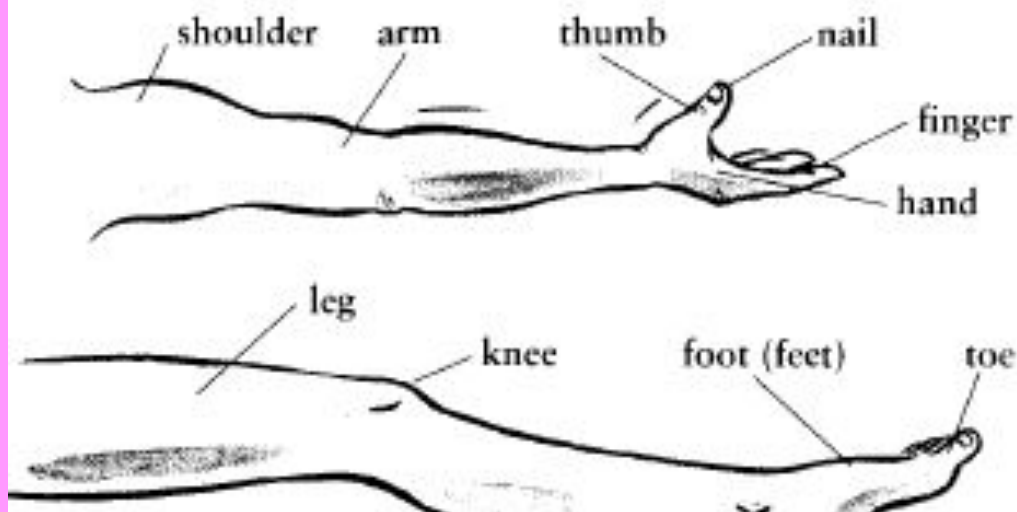
